ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CLEAR LAKE CITY COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 4.03 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation which Articles of Amendment alter Article V of such Articles of Incorporation by substituting language to provide that the number of Trustees shall be 9, to be selected and to serve in accordance with the By-Laws, and deleting prior provisions for eleven Trustees determined in accordance with the By-Laws.

- 1. The name of the corporation is Clear Lake City Community Association, Inc.
- 2. The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation on June 11, 2002. Article V of the Articles of Incorporation hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"The direction and management of the affairs of this corporation and the control and disposition of its properties and funds shall be vested in a Board of Trustees composed of 9 persons. The Trustees shall be elected and shall serve in accordance with the By-Laws of the corporation."

3. The amendment was adopted in the following manner:

The amendment was adopted at a meeting of the Board of Trustees held on June 11, 2002, and received the vote of a majority of the Trustees in office, there being no members having voting rights in respect thereof.
