#### **President Report**

President Terry Canup wished everyone a nice day.

#### Treasurer Report

Treasurer Glenda Stroud gave the Treasurer's Report and reviewed the January financials. She reported that the Wells Fargo CD will mature on March 29, 2019 and we will select the reinvestment at the March meeting. The Treasurer also reported that this is the slow season, so \$75k operational funds from Shell FCU was transferred to operating on January 30.

#### General Manager's Report

The January collections from past due assessments and transfer fees was \$26,590.62. The total outstanding Accounts Receivable is \$290,674.69.

The emergency repairs that were approved at the emergency board meeting were completed on 14 February 2019. The backflow device was replaced and 50 ft of C-900 pipe was installed to replace the old iron pipe in the outdoor pool area that had ruptured.

A fight amongst three ladies occurred during the Clear Lake Boys Basketball game on 02 February 2019. The police were called, and the officer reviewed the surveillance video. The Vice President of the Clear Lake Boys Basketball complimented the employees for handling the situation professionally. A copy of the surveillance tape was provided to HPD for this assault case and the three ladies are banned from attending future games.

The divider wall in the gym is in need of repair. Although numerous quotes were requested, several companies would not provide a quote but referred us to Academic Specialties. The Board reviewed the quotes we were able to obtain.

The OBW trustee appointment application deadline is March 7, 2019 at 5pm. To date, zero applications have been submitted.

The Friendswood Ranch property appraisals should be in soon for the two properties located on Bay Area Blvd.



Recreation: The Camp Clear Lake registration packet and website was updated. Last year we had over 500 children attend Camp Clear Lake. Summer lifeguard and camp counselor interviews are occurring.

The aquatic and maintenance staff are working hard to prepare the outdoor pools for inspection and opening day. The Easter Event and Craft Show will be held on Saturday, April 13 from 10am-1pm.
