A few weeks ago, you may have been part of the progress of SB 6 and SB 54, both of which have passed through the Senate. SB-6 also was adopted as an urgency clause, meaning that once it passes through the Assembly, it will be implemented immediately.

We still have a lot of work to do before these bills become law. We need to continue petitioning and lobbying for both bills to our assembly members-- writing letters, making phone calls, and sending emails to our assembly member representatives. There is no further need to contact senate representatives, as they have already voted.

AB 1109: The Safe Consumer Lending Act (Kalra)

CLUE is engaged in a new and important campaign to address the dangerous and unjust issue of predatory lending with payday, installment and car title loans. Right now, we are supporting a critical bill that would put needed protections in place for working families. AB 1109 would cap the annual percentage rate (APR) for all high-dollar consumer loans between \$2,500 and \$10,000 at 24 percent. This number may not seem low, but there is currently NO cap on interest rates, meaning families in tight situations are often preyed upon with interest rates above 100 and even 1000 percent, trapping them in debt cycles with no end in sight. This must stop!

SB 562: The Healthy California Act (Lara/Atkins)

This Senate Bill addresses the current healthcare crisis by taking a bold step toward a singlepayer health care system and will provide timely access to comprehensive care for EVERYONE, commonly referred to as "Single Payer Healthcare" or Medicare for All. This bill will combat rising healthcare costs to individuals, employers, and taxpayers, and guarantee that no one goes without healthcare.
