

## **RNC WISCONSIN**

Slated system

Important Dates:

- February - April, 2016: District caucuses
- April 5, 2016: Primary vote
- TBA: District Executive Committee meetings

Number of Delegates:

- 24 District delegates
- 15 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 42

Process:

1. District caucuses are held which provide a proposed list of district delegates for each presidential candidate. These delegates are not elected.
2. A primary vote is taken that determines how many delegates each presidential candidate will receive.
3. District executive committee meetings are held during which the district chairman, in consultation with the winning presidential candidate, selects the district-delegates that will go to the National Convention.
4. The at-large delegates are selected directly by the winning presidential candidate to represent them at the National Convention.

Allocation of Delegates:

- At the district level, delegates are split evenly between the 8 congressional districts.. The delegates are all pledged to the presidential candidate that receives the majority of the vote in that district
- At the state level, 15 at-large delegates are pledged to the presidential candidate that receives the most vote during the primary vote.

Filing information:

- Since delegates are chosen by the district chairman and presidential candidates, there are no filing requirements.
