Slated delegate System

Important Dates:

- April 19, 2016: Primary vote
- May 25 – May 26, 2016: State Party Committee Meeting

Number of Delegates:

- 81 District delegates
- 11 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 95

Process:

1. Prior to the primary, presidential candidates chose a slate of delegates they would like to represent them at the district-level.
2. There is a primary vote by which delegates are allocated to each candidate.
3. At state committee meeting, at-large delegates are elected according to the outcomes of the primary.

Allocation of Delegates:

- At the district level, if a candidate receives more than 50% of the vote, or only one candidate receives over 20%, they get all of the delegates from that district
 - If 2 candidates receive over 20% of the vote the highest vote getter receives two delegates and the other receives one.
 - If no candidate receives over 20% of the vote, the state committee shall choose the allocation of delegates.
- At the state level, 11 at-large delegates are allocated to any candidate receiving over 20% of the vote, unless one candidate receives over 50% of the vote in which case they receive all the at-large candidates.

Filing information:

- Since delegates are slated by the presidential candidate prior to the primary, there is no filing required of delegates.
