

RNC CONNECTICUT

Slated delegate System

Important Dates:

- April 26, 2016: Primary vote
- May 20, 2016: State committee meeting

Number of Delegates:

- 15 District delegates
- 10 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 28

Process:

1. There is a primary vote by which delegates are allocated to each candidate.
2. At the state committee meeting, the presidential candidates that received delegates, based on the result of the primary, submit the names of their desired delegates which are then approved by the committee.

Allocation of Delegates:

- If one candidate receives 50% of the vote or more, they receive all 28 of Connecticut's delegates.
- If no candidate receives an overall majority of the primary vote:
 - The 3 district level the delegates from each Congressional district will be given to the highest vote getting presidential candidate in that district
 - The 10 at-large delegates will be allocated to the candidates proportionally.

Filing information:

- Those wishing to be delegate do not file with the state party but are chosen by the presidential candidate to represent them.
