2-tiered system

Important Dates:

- Febraury 18 – May 3: Local meetings
- March 1, 2016: Primary vote
- April 22 - May 14, 2016: Filing deadline for district-level delegates
- April 30 – May 21, 2016: Congressional district conventions
- June 1, 2016: Filing deadline for at-large delegates
- June 18, 2016: State convention

Number of Delegates:

- 33 District delegates
- 13 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 49

Process:

1. Local meetings are held in each city or county to elect delegates to the congressional district conventions and the state convention.
2. There is a primary vote by which delegates are allocated to each candidate by the winner of a congressional district.
3. There are congressional district conventions held separately from the state convention in order to elect the district level delegates.
4. The state convention meets to elect at-large delegates.

Allocation of Delegates:

- At the district level, delegates are split evenly between the 11 congressional districts. The presidential candidate in each district that receives the most votes gets all 3 delegates from that district.
- At the state level, 13 at-large delegates are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state. At-large delegates are allocated entirely to one candidate if that candidate receives over 50% of the voter, if not; they are allocated proportionally to all candidates that receive over 15% of the vote.

Filing information:

- District delegates must file for election in the congressional district that they live in.
- At-large delegates must submit their filings to the state party no less than 16 days before the state convention.
- District delegates must submit their filings to the district chairman and secretary no less than 7 days before the district conventions.
- Those wishing to be delegates should submit their candidate statements to the State Republican Party at 115 E. Grace Street Richmond, VA 23219.
