2-tiered system

Important Dates:

- March 22, 2016: Neighborhood Caucuses
- April 16, 2016: State Convention

Number of Delegates:

- 12 District delegates
- 25 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 40

Process:

1. Neighborhood caucuses are held in each precinct to elect delegates to the state convention. There is also a presidential preference vote taken at the caucuses.
2. The state convention meets to elect at-large and district delegates based on the allocation from the neighborhood caucuses.

Allocation of Delegates:

- At the district level, delegates are allocated based on the results of the presidential preference expressed at the neighborhood caucuses and are allocated proportionally.
- At the state level, 25 at-large delegates are allocated proportionally based on the results of the presidential preference of the state.

Filing information:

- Those wishing to be a district level delegate or at-large delegate candidates must file with the State Party prior to the state convention at 117 E South Temple St Salt Lake City, UT 84111
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live.
