

## **RNC SOUTH CAROLINA**

2 tiered delegate system

### Important Dates:

- February 20, 2016: Primary vote
- March, 2016: County conventions
- April, 2016: District conventions
- May 21, 2016: State convention

### Number of Delegates:

- 21 District delegates
- 26 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 50

### Process:

1. There will be a primary vote that will determine the allocation of both district-level delegates and at-large delegates.
2. County conventions will be held to elect delegates to the congressional district conventions and the state convention.
3. District conventions will be held to elect district-level delegates to the National Convention according to the results of the primary.
4. At the state convention, district-level delegates and at-large delegates will be elected according to the results of the primary.

### Allocation of Delegates:

- At the district level, delegates are split evenly between the 7 congressional districts. The candidate that receives the most vote in each congressional district is awarded all 3 delegates from that district.
- At the state level, 26 at-large delegates are pledged to the candidate that wins the most votes statewide.

### Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegates or an at-large delegate, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Republican Party at 1913 Marion St. Columbia, SC 29201.
- District delegates must file for election 7 days prior to the District Convention.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
