2 tiered delegate system

Important Dates:

- May 10, 2016: Primary vote
- June 3 - June 12, 2016: County conventions
- July 9, 2016: State convention

Number of Delegates:

- 9 District delegates
- 24 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 36

Process:

1. A primary vote is held to determine the allocation of delegates to presidential candidates.
2. County conventions will be held to elect delegates to the state convention
3. At the state convention, at-large delegates and district-level delegates will be elected according to the results of the primary. District-level delegates will be selected by district caucuses and at-large delegates will be selected by the vote of the entire convention

Allocation of Delegates:

- At the district level, delegates are split evenly between the 3 congressional districts. The winner of each congressional district receives all 3 delegates from that district.
- At the state level, 24 at-large delegates are pledged to the candidate that received the most votes statewide.

Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegates or an at-large delegate, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Republican party at 1610 N St. Lincoln, NE 68058.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
