2-tiered system

Important Dates:

- March 5, 2016: Municipal Caucuses
- April 16, 2016: State Convention

Number of Delegates:

- 6 District delegates
- 14 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 23

Process:

1. Municipal caucuses are held in each municipality to elect delegates to the state convention and the district caucuses that occur at the convention. There is also a presidential preference vote taken at the municipal caucuses that is used in determining the allocation of delegates.
2. The state convention meets to elect at-large and district delegates. District caucuses meet to elect 3 district level delegates from each congressional district and the entire convention elects the at-large delegates.

Allocation:

- All of the delegates from Maine are allocated based on the precinct caucus votes. If any candidate receives more than 50% of the vote then they are allocated all of Maine's delegates. If not, delegates are allocated proportionally.

Filing Information:

- To qualify as a district-level or an at-large delegate, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Republican Party at 9 Higgins Street, Augusta ME 04330.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live.
