2-tiered system

Important Dates:

- March 22, 2016: Primary vote
- April 2 - April 16, 2016: Legislative district caucuses and county conventions
- May 14, 2016: State convention

Number of Delegates:

- 27 District delegates
- 28 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 58

Process:

1. There is a primary vote by which the winning candidate receives all of the state's delegates.
2. Legislative district conventions or county conventions, depending on their populations, are held to elect delegates to the state convention. Allocation of how many delegates each convention elects is dependent on the amount of registered Republicans.
3. The state convention meets to elect at-large and district delegates based on the winner of the primary vote. There are district caucuses held at the convention to elect the district-level delegates. The convention meets as whole to elect the at-large delegates.

Allocation of Delegates:

- All 58 of Arizona's delegates are allocated to the presidential candidate receiving the most votes in the primary.

Filing information:

- Both district-level and at-large delegates must file statements indicating their presidential preference with the Arizona State Republican Party at 3501 N. 24th St. Phoenix, AZ 85016
- District-level delegates must file in the district in which they live.
