1 tiered system

Important Dates:

- April 26, 2016: Primary vote
- May 2, 2016: Filing deadline for district-level delegates
- May 30, 2015: Congressional district caucuses
- May 31, 2016: Filing deadline for at-large delegates and PLEOs
- June 9, 2016: State party committee meeting

Number of Delegates:

- 33 District delegates
- 11 At-large delegates
- 7 Party leaders and elected officials (PLEOs)
- 14 Super-delegates
- Total: 65

Process:

1. There is a primary vote taken which determines the proportional allocation of delegates to the district and state conventions for each candidate that receives over 15% of the vote.
2. Congressional district conventions are held to elect the district level delegates
3. At the state committee meeting, at-large delegates and PLEOs are elected by the party committee.

Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level.
- At the district level, delegates are split between the 5 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district.
- At the state level, 11 at-large delegates and 7 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state.

- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live.
