1 tiered system

Important Dates:

- March 1, 2016: Primary vote
- March 18, 2016: Filing deadline for district-level delegates
- April 16, 2016: Congressional district caucuses
- May 17, 2016: Filing deadline for at-large and PLEO delegates
- June 11, 2016: State committee meeting

Number of Delegates:

- 64 District delegates
- 21 At-large delegates
- 13 Party leaders and elected officials (PLEOs)
- 15 Super-delegates
- Total: 113

Process:

1. There is a primary vote taken which determines the proportional allocation of delegates to the district and state conventions for each candidate that receives over 15% of the vote.
2. Congressional district caucuses are held to elect the district level delegates
3. At the state committee meeting, at-large delegates and PLEOs are elected by the party committee.

Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level.
- At the district level, delegates are split between the 14 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district.
- At the state level, 21 at-large delegates and 13 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state.

Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level, at-large delegate, or PLEO, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Democratic Party at 501 Pulliam Street, Suite 400 Atlanta GA 30312
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
