One-tier system

Important Dates:

- May 3, 2016: Primary vote
- June 3, 2016: Filing deadline for district-level delegates, at-large delegates, and PLEOs
- June 18, 2016: State convention

Number of Delegates:

- 46 District-Level Delegates
- 15 At-Large Delegates
- 9 Pledged Party Leaders and Elected Officials (PLEOs)
- 9 Super-Delegates
- Total: 79

Process:

1. The primary vote occurs and determines the number of delegates allocated to each candidate that receives more than 15% of the vote.
2. At the state convention, both district-level delegates, at-large delegates, and PLEOs are elected according to the allocation of the primary.

Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level.
- At the district level, delegates are split between the 14 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district.
- At the state level, 15 at-large delegates and 9 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state.

Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegate, at-large delegate, or PLEO, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Democratic Party at 115 W Washington St., Suite 1165, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46204
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
