1 tiered system

Important Dates:

- March 5, 2016: Primary vote
- March 11, 2016: Filing deadline for district-level delegates
- April 30, 2016: Congressional district caucuses
- May 13, 2016: Filing deadline for at-large delegates and PLEOs
- May 28, 2016: State party committee meeting

Number of Delegates:

- 35 District delegates
- 12 At-large delegates
- 7 Party leaders and elected officials (PLEOs)
- 7 Super-delegates
- Total: 61

Process:

1. There is a primary vote taken which determines the proportional allocation of delegates to the district and state conventions
2. Congressional district caucuses are held to elect the district level delegates. These caucus votes are done mainly by mail in ballots. Ballots are mailed to every Democrat in the state that requests one.
3. At the state committee meeting, at-large delegates and PLEOs are elected by the party committee.

Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level.
- At the district level, delegates are split between the 6 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district.
- At the state level, 12 at-large delegates and 7 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state.

Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegates, at-large delegate, or PLEO, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Democratic Party at 701 Government Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70802,
- Forms will be available at the State Party office beginning on February 11, 2016.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
