

## **RNC COLORADO**

3 tiered delegate system

### Important Dates:

- March 1, 2016: Precinct caucuses
- March 30, 2016: County conventions
- April 7 - April 8, 2016: Congressional district conventions
- April 12, 2016: State convention

### Number of Delegates:

- 21 District delegates
- 13 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 37

### Process:

1. Precinct caucuses will be held to elect delegates to the county conventions but there will be no primary preference vote to allocate delegates to the national convention.
2. County conventions will be held to elect delegates to the state convention and congressional district conventions.
3. At the congressional district conventions, district-level delegates will be elected according to the results of the primary
4. At the state convention, at-large delegates will be elected but they will not be based off the results of a presidential preference vote.

### Allocation of Delegates:

- The delegates go to the national convention unbound by any commitment to a presidential candidate and therefore there are no rules for allocation.

### Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegate or at-large delegate a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Republican Party at 5950 S. Willow Drive, Suite 301 | Greenwood Village, CO 80111.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
