3-tiered system

Important Dates:

- February 20, 2016: Precinct meetings
 - Only for precincts with a population over 80,000
- March, 1, 2016: Primary vote
- March 20, 2016: Precinct meetings and county conventions
 - Precincts with less than a population of 80,000 meet the same day as the county conventions
- April 9, 2016: Congressional District Conventions
- May 20 – May 21, 2016: State Convention

Number of Delegates:

- 42 District delegates
- 31 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 76

Process:

1. Precinct caucuses are held to elect delegates to the county conventions.
2. The Primary vote occurs and the number of delegates each candidate receives is allocated based on the results of the vote.
3. County conventions meet to elect delegates to the state convention and the congressional district conventions.
4. Congressional District conventions meet to elect district-level delegates based on the allocation from the primary vote.
5. The state convention meets to elect at-large delegates based on the allocation from the primary vote.

Allocation of Delegates:

- District level delegates are allocated by which candidate receives a majority in congressional district. If no candidate receives a majority that the top vote getter receives 2/3 delegates and the second vote getter receives one.
- At-large delegates are distributed proportionally but to receive any at-large delegates, a presidential candidate must receive at least 20% of the vote.

Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level or an at-large delegate, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Republican Party at 5920 Roswell Rd NE Ste B115 Atlanta, GA.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live.
