

## **RNC NORTH CAROLINA**

3-tiered system

### Important Dates:

- February, 2016: Precinct conventions
- March, 1, 2016: Primary vote
- March, 2016: County conventions
- April 2 – April 23, 2016: Congressional District Conventions
- June 3 – June 5, 2016: State Convention

### Number of Delegates:

- 39 District delegates
- 30 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials
- Total: 72

### Process:

1. Precinct conventions are held to elect delegates to the county conventions.
2. The Primary vote occurs and the number of delegates each candidate receives is allocated based on the results of the vote.
3. County conventions meet to elect delegates to the state convention and the congressional district conventions.
4. Congressional District conventions meet to elect district-level delegates based on the allocation from the primary vote.
5. The state convention meets to elect at-large delegates based on the allocation from the primary vote.

### Allocation of Delegates:

- At the district level, delegates are split evenly between the 13 congressional districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district.
- At the state level, 30 at-large delegates are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state.

### Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegates or an at-large delegate, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Republican Party at 1506 Hillsborough St, Raleigh, NC 27605.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
