

## **DNC NEBRASKA**

3 tiered delegate system

### Important Dates:

- March 5, 2016: Precinct caucuses
- May 19 - May 29, 2016: County conventions
- June 1, 2016: Filing deadline for district level, at-large and PLEO delegates
- June 17 -19 2016: State convention

### Number of Delegates:

- 17 District delegates
- 6 At-large delegates
- 3 Party leaders and elected officials (PLEOs)
- 5 Super delegates
- Total: 31

### Process:

1. Precinct caucuses will be held to elect delegates to the county conventions as well as have a primary preference vote that will determine the allocation of delegates to each presidential candidate.
2. County conventions will be held to elect delegates to the state convention.
3. At the state convention, at-large delegates, district-level delegates and PLEOs will be elected according to the results of the primary.

### Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level.
- At the district level, delegates are split between the 3 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to candidates proportional to the portion of the vote they receive in that district during the state convention district votes
- At the state level, 6 at-large delegates and 3 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state convention

### Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegates, an at-large delegate, or a PLEO, a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed with the State Democratic Party and returned to the State party at 421 S. 9th Street, Suite 233, Lincoln, NE 68508, or via e-mail at [caucus@nebraskademocrats.org](mailto:caucus@nebraskademocrats.org)
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
