

DNC NEVADA

3 tiered delegate system

Important Dates:

- February 20, 2016: Precinct caucuses
- April 2, 2016: County conventions
- June 4, 2016: State convention and Filing deadline for district-level delegates, at-large delegates, and PLEOs

Number of Delegates:

- 20 District delegates
- 7 At-large delegates
- 4 Party leaders and elected officials (PLEOs)
- 8 Super delegates
- Total: 39

Process:

1. At the precinct caucuses, delegates to the county conventions are elected. There is also a presidential preference vote taken at each caucus but it does not determine the allocation of delegates to presidential candidates.
2. County conventions are held to elect delegates to the state convention.
3. At the state convention, at-large delegates, district-level delegates, and PLEOs will be elected according to the results of the caucus votes. At the state convention, congressional district caucuses meet to elect the district-level delegates and the entire state convention elects the at-large delegates and PLEOs.

Allocation of Delegates:

- A candidate must receive 15% of the vote to get delegates at either the district or state level.
- The allocation of all delegates is not determined by the caucus votes. It is determined by the vote taken at the state convention by the delegates in attendance of the convention.
- District-level delegates are divided evenly between the 4 congressional districts based on the Democratic make-up of those districts. The delegates are pledged to proportionally to candidates based on the vote taken at each of the congressional district caucuses at the state convention.
- 7 At-large delegates and 4 PLEOs are pledged to the candidates based proportionally on the votes of the entire state convention.

Filing information:

- To qualify as a district-level delegate, an at-large delegate, or a PLEO a statement of candidacy designating the presidential preference must be filed in person, by mail, or by fax to the Nevada State Democratic Party, 6233 Dean Martin Drive, Las Vegas, NV 89118.
- District-level delegates must file in the district or sub district in which they live
