

Here is a short list that we took from <u>Nerd Wallet</u> of banks to get you started as you are looking at moving your money. The ratings systems are Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFI), Global Alliance for Banking Values (GABV), and Certified B Corporation (B Corp). These are certifications that indicate an institution is working toward environmental and social governance and/or community development. The banks that we <u>know</u> are not invested in weapons are marked with an *. This is not an exhaustive list and there are other options out there, but this is meant to give you a place to start.

When you're looking for a bank, ask questions. Give them a call or go in and visit. Let them know what you're looking for in a bank.
