EverySight's participation in their upcoming cycling expo event.**

EverySight is owned by Elbit Systems, Israel's largest publicly traded weapons company. At the Sea Otter Classic cycling expo, EverySight will be demonstrating Raptor augmented reality glasses which, according to the company, allow cyclists to ride like a F35 fighter pilot. We are calling on the Sea Otter Classic to respect human rights by canceling EverySight's participation in their expo.

Why boycott EverySight and Elbit Systems? Elbit Systems has been involved in all of Israel's major offenses on Gaza, including the 2015 assault where the Israeli military killed over 550 Palestinian children, and during the Great Return March where Israeli snipers intentionally shot and killed hundreds of nonviolent protesters according to findings published by the U.N.

Elbit Systems is also complicit in the repression on the U.S.-Mexico border. Elbit contracts with U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) to provide sensors, cameras, radars and "Integrated Fixed Towers" in the Arizona and Texas borderlands and is eager to cash in on Trump's attempts to further militarize the U.S.-Mexico border.
