In 2011, [Stan VanderWerf](#) founded Advanced Capitol, LLC, an aerospace and defense-consulting firm. In 2014, Stan created Colorado Springs' first dedicated 3D printing company, CEM-Tek USA.

Stan believes in smaller government, fiscal restraint, and the power of the free market; also, he knows firsthand the challenges that local businesses face in surviving and growing. Stan served in the U.S. Air Force for 27 years focused on R&D, production, and sustainment of a wide variety of products from space systems to aircraft, electronics, communications, and more.
