**DEPARTMENT OF AGING (LADOA) - SENIOR COMMUNITY SERVICE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM**

LADOA, in partnership with EWDD, administers the **Senior Community Service Employment Program** which provides subsidized, temporary, part-time community service work-based training for low income persons age 55 or older who are unemployed and trying to re-enter the job market. Through this program, older workers have access to on-the-job training as well as employment assistance through a network of local not for profits, government agencies, and WorkSource Centers.
