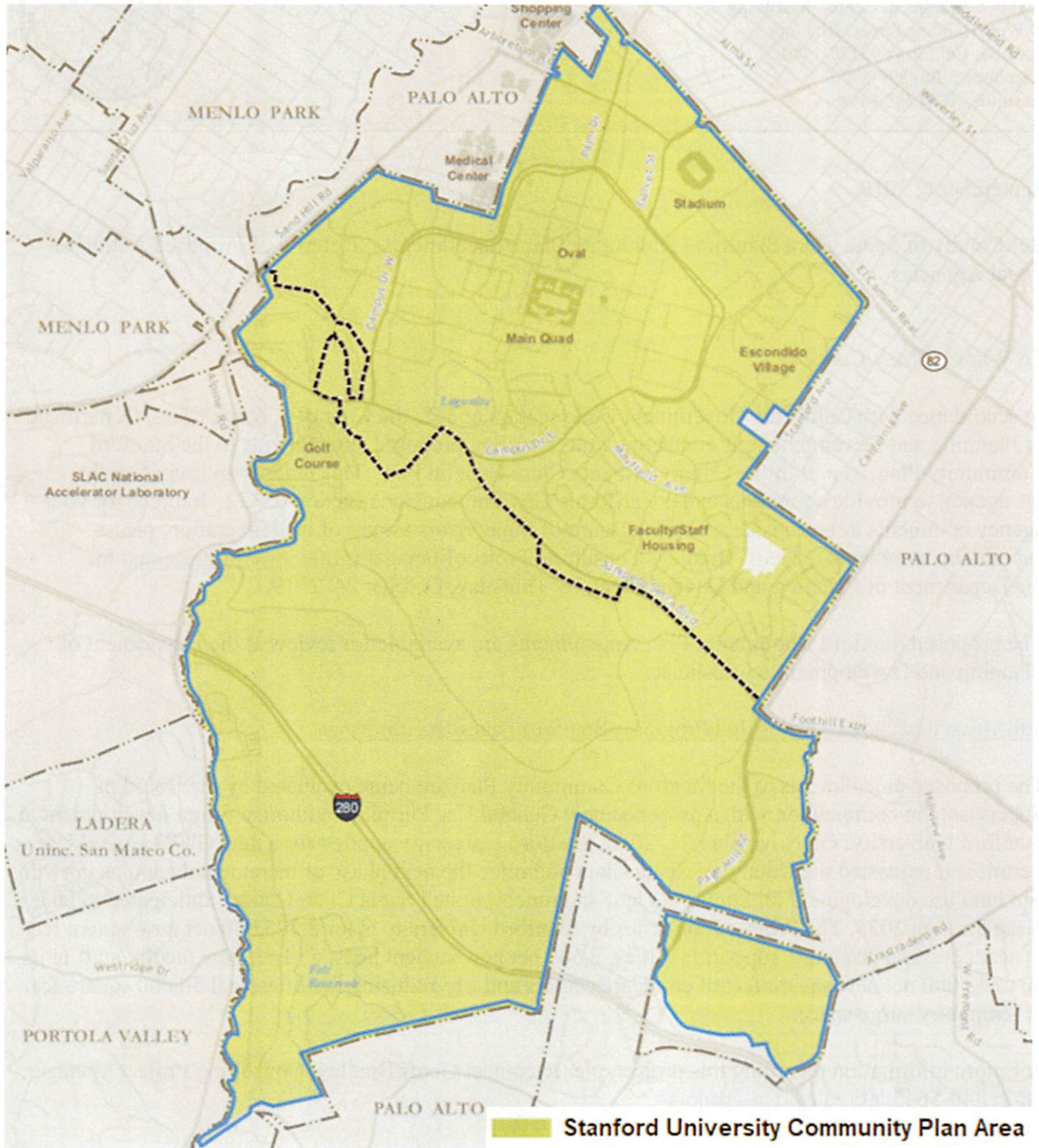
In accordance with California Government Code section 65352, the County of Santa Clara, Department of Planning and Development, is contacting you regarding proposed amendments to the Stanford Community Plan, as part of the County of Santa Clara General Plan. This letter is an invitation for the agency to provide comments under California Government Code section 65352. The proposed amendments to the Stanford Community Plan are being evaluated by the Board of Supervisors in combination with a proposed new General Use Permit to authorize future development at Stanford University. On November 21, 2016, Stanford University applied for a new GUP General Use Permit and requested the County of Santa Clara authorize the next phase of incremental campus growth and land use development on Stanford's land in unincorporated Santa Clara County anticipated to take place through 2035. The Project applied for by Stanford University is for 2,275,000 net new square feet of academic and academic support facilities, 2,600 net new student beds, 550 net new faculty/staff units, up to 40,000 net new square feet of childcare centers and trip-reducing facilities, and 50,000 square feet of temporary surge space.
