### **Withdrawing Nominations**

Nominations **cannot be withdrawn after 12:00pm Noon Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 11/12/2020**.

### **Candidate Statements**

Up to seven days after the close of nominations, a candidate for a Group or Branch office may submit to the returning officer a biography and/or a statement in support of their candidature only, for distribution by the returning officer with ballot material. The statement shall not exceed 200 words. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer **by 12:00pm Noon (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 18/12/2020** can be accepted.

### **Voting Period**

The ballot, if required, will open on **21/01/2021 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 25/02/2021**.

### **Scrutineers**

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
