Batteries

Portable chargers (solar, stored)
First-aid kit
Medical items (prescriptions, etc.)
Blankets
Clothing
Baby items (clothes, food, diapers, etc.)
Local maps
Garbage bags
NOAA weather radio
Plastic sheeting
Duct tape

Long-term supplies

7-14 day supply of food and water
Cash, traveler's checks, change
Emergency first-aid reference materials
Sleeping bags/warm blankets
Household chlorine bleach (and medicine dropper)
Fire extinguisher
Personal hygiene supplies and feminine products
Mess kits, paper cups/plates, plastic utensils, paper towels
Paper, pencils, pens
Entertainment items
