What: S.169

On Friday, March 22nd, the Senate passed S.169, a bill which will require a 24-hour waiting period to purchase a handgun. This bill is in reaction to a single individual who took his life with a handgun he had purchased the same day when this type of incident has occurred only 4 times in 20 years.

In an effort to stop people from committing suicide by firearm, our legislators are poised to disregard their oath to protect the ability of a Vermonter to purchase the type of firearm that is most used for defense, all in an effort to try and stop someone who is intent on killing themselves, even though Vermont has a death with dignity law.

The problem is people who need help: Not the means which they use.
