Re: complaint against officers

Mr. Andersen:

On Dec. 29, 2015, Carolyn Kechley came to Chaska Police Department and provided a letter reportedly written by you regarding the events surrounding your most recent arrest. In that statement, you alleged that "Chaska Police brutality followed at around the hours of 7:00 a.m." You also indicate wishing to speak to an attorney regarding that incident.

On Dec. 31, 2015, at about 1030 hrs, I met with you at Carver County Jail. I advised you that I was in possession of the letter and would investigate any allegations of officer "brutality." I provided you information about how to contact me to make a formal statement regarding the incident, after consulting with an attorney. You volunteered some information about the incident that suggested some serious allegations. However, because of your in-custody status and your request for an attorney, I asked you no questions but requested you contact me at a later date so I could take a complete statement. I photographed alleged injuries at your request.

Since that time, you have failed to contact me to make a statement regarding your concerns and you have not signed an Initial Citizen's Complaint Form. Therefore, at this time, I will be unable to investigate your claims and will be closing this case.
