The listed male was observed remaining in the area after Dispersal Orders and Arrest Orders were given. He was observed numerous times throwing bottles at line Officers. I observed him numerous times run away to retrieve more bottles and return and throw them at Officers again. His description was given to all Officers and aired over the radio. He was observed several times running from 13th/4th st Se retrieving bottles and returning to throw them at Officers. He fled as we attempted to mark him with marking rounds. He retrieved rocks and concrete chunks. He threw a baseball size concrete chuck that hit me in the foot as I was trying to mark him again. He again fled. After a period of time he was reported to have been back near 13th/4th se. We arrived and observed him. He was arrested and later booked HCJ. PC authorized by Lt.Kingsbury #3702

On 04/12/2014, I was assigned to Squad 1201 with Lt. Kingsbury, Officer Sheneman, and Officer Blad. We were assigned as a Mobile Force for the area near the University of Minnesota Dinkytown. I was assigned to deploy my Department issued 40mm launcher. At 1600 hours I was issued 18 green tip marking rounds. The rounds have green chalk inside. I was wearing full authorized Minneapolis Police Uniform.

At approx 2100 hours we met 1280 and 1281 at 14th Avenue Se/4th Street Se and awaited further orders. The hockey game ended and crowds began to gather. We provided line support on the east side of this intersection. The crowd continued to grow and moved into the entire intersection. Dispersal Orders and Arrest Orders were given for the crowd to leave numerous times over PA system. The momentum of the crowd continued to grow and become more hostile towards Police. Beer cans and bottles were being throw from inside the crowd at Police.

Officers attempted to move people to the north with line Officers and the mounted patrol. People formed back at the northwest corner of the intersection. I observed people start to climb up the pole of a Minneapolis Police stationary mobile camera. The unit is very expensive and unstable. I deployed a green marking round at the individual half way up the pole. He jumped down and ran away westbound.

We attempted to move the crowd with line Officers westbound on 4th Street Se. The crowd started throwing bottles at Officers. I along with several Officers observed a white male, blond hair, muscular, 21-24, wearing a grey long sleeve t-shirt with a maroon t-shirt draped around his neck throwing numerous bottles at Officers. He would throw them, run to the west to find more and come back and throw again. This male continued this behavior for the next hour.

We moved west and secured the intersection at 4th Avenue Se/13th Avenue Se. Here we continued to watch this same male throw objects at us. He moved behind a bus stop shelter 25yards west of this intersection and threw a rock. When he moved away from the shelter I attempted to mark him with a green marking round, The round impacted on the edge of the bus shelter instead. He ran northwest to a dumpster behind an apartment building and opened it grabbing bottles. He started running back towards us and I deployed a 40mm marking round at him from a distance of 50 yards. I missed and impacted a grass backstop. Another Officer deployed 40mm marking rounds at him at the same time. I passed this information to all Officers in our area. He came back the the alley and hurled a chunk of concrete as I deployed another 40mm marking round at him. The concrete chunk landed on my foot. He again took off towards the north. I aired this information to all Officers along with his description. I retrieved the chunk of concrete, which is the size of a baseball and secured it in our vehicle.

We started doing mobile patrols looking for this male. Awhile later Officers informed us that a male matching the desription was near the Library Bar at 13th/4th Se. We went to this area and I immediately observed this male near the entrance of the Library Bar. I aired this information and requested an arrest team along with mounted patrol to assist. I exited the squad and approached the male allowing a stand off distance. I put myself between the door of the bar and the suspect so he could not get inside. I ordered him several times to get to the ground. It should be noted be was very muscular and a lot younger then myself. He had showed his violent behavior despite all the commands and arrest orders given. He still continued to stand and look around. The horses came up but they could not dismount to arrest him. I again ordered him onto the ground as I move toward him. I knew we had to arrest him fast before the crowd turned on us. As I moved towards him I used my less-lethal 40mm launcher to give him a stun blow to the stomach. He then fell to the ground and was handcuffed without further incident. He was helped up and walked to the booking van. I was informed by booking van Officers that his name is Michael Conley Juberian, 06/20/1991. He was booking number A009. His clothes were retrieved and property inventoried along with the chunk of concrete.

After the main push of rioters went northbound on 4th St SE I observed a stocky white male (AP/Juberian) wearing a gray shirt and had another shirt around his neck throwing items at officers near the corner of 13th Av SE/4th St SE. I tried to mark AP/Juberian two times from a long distance. One of the rounds hit the ground in front of him and I am unsure if the second round hit him. After this I lost sight of AP/Juberian. I then observed him come back to a dumpster in an alley and begin to grab items out and then start throwing rocks at officers.

I then observed AP/Juberian move towards an apartment building across the street from the Library Bar, and kept peeking around a corner to see when he could assault officers with rocks. I was unable to get any more 40mm marking rounds at AP/Juberian as there was never a safe time to do so.

I was assigned to CART Team 1 on 04/12/2014. Officers were trying to disperse a crowd of rioters at the intersection of 13 Ave SE and 4th St SE. I was standing next to Officer C. Taylor when this group began throwing bottles and chunks of asphalt at officers. I saw a stocky white male (AP/Juberian) wearing a grey shirt and he also had a darker colored shirt wrapped around his neck. AP/Juberian would come out from behind the building and throw objects at us. I tried marking him 3 separate times, but did not mark him. He even went to the extent of grabbing items from a dumpster to throw at us.

I then saw AP Juberian throw a large object that hit Officer C. Taylor in the foot. Officer Taylor stated "Did you see that"? I saw a large chunk of concrete laying next to his foot.

We then tried to located Ap Juberian but he had ran away. I was infomed that he was latter found and arrested.

VIDEO

On June 5th 2014, I was advised that Sgt. Kent Warnberg had WCCO video footage of the hockey riots. Sgt. Warnberg informed me that the arrested party in this case (Juberian) was on the video. The WCCO video is separated into chapters. Sgt. Warnberg stated that he saw Juberian under chapter "MM BROLL 1", between 03:47 minutes and 04:08 minutes.

Sgt. Warnberg was using the WCCO video for another case and he inventoried the video as evidence at the Minneapolis Property and Evidence room under CCN 14-116006.

I submitted a Crime Lab request asking that the Crime Lab make viewable copies of the video so that I could have my own copy to view for this case.

The Crime Lab made copies. One set of copies for evidence and one set for me to view on my computer. The Crime Lab put the video footage onto 3 discs. The discs were labelled 1, 2 and 3. Disc 3 is footage from a helicopter. Discs 1 and 2 are ground level footage.

On 06-24 and 06-25-2014, I viewed the WCCO footage.

I did see the male Sgt. Warnberg was talking about on chapter MM BROLL 1 (Disc 1).

The video shows a muscular male who has taken off his shirts. He is shirtless but holding onto at least two shirts (a greyish shirt and a maroon sweatshirt). He is wearing tan or grey pants. He had blondish, short hair. The male appears to be Michael Juberian. I compared the video images to Juberian's booking photo. I also read the descriptions of Juberian's clothing in this report and it appears that that clothing in the video matches the clothing descriptions in this report.

I watched the entire DISC 1. Juberian can be seen at various times through out the footage. Every time he is seen on the footage, he is in the middle of the disturbance/riot.

Under MM BROLL 1 at 3:47- 4:08 minutes: Juberian is shirtless, in the middle of the street with a crowd of people, many who are sitting down in the middle of the street.

Under MM BROLL 2 at 0630 minutes: Juberian is seen in the back ground in a crowd. He is wearing a maroon sweatshirt, the grey/tan pants and what appear to be dark colored shoes with white soles.

At 0700 minutes: Juberian is seen on the right side of the screen taking his sweatshirt off and becoming shirtless. He is in the middle of the crowds.

At 0720 minutes: Juberian can be seen in the background in the crowds.

I watched DISC 2. Juberian can be seen at various times through out the footage. Everytime he is seen, he is in the crowds where the action is.

On disc 2 under "STR DINKY TOWN FANS BROLL 04102014" at 1:04 minutes, Juberian is walking around outside Goldy's Bar on 4th St SE. This footage captures a better image of Juberian's shoes which appear to have an orange Nike Swoosh on them.

At 1:30 minutes: Juberian is in the crowds carrying another male above his head high in the air.

At 2:16 minutes: a bottle is thrown at police. As the camera pans, Juberian can be seen standing on a corner with a crowd. The bottle appeared to have been thrown from that direction.

Under "STR DINKY TOWN FANS SOTS 04122014" at 00:16 minutes: Juberian walks up to the WCCO camera capturing a close up image of him.

Under "STR DINKY TOWN FANS ARRESTED MM" at 00:50 minutes: Juberian is with a crowd of people on the corner of the intersection when a bottle is thrown at police. It is unknown who threw that particular bottle.

I viewed DISC 3. The footage is a birds eye view from a helicopter and shows the scale of the riot and disturbances.

On 06-25-2014, I took a screen shot of the video of Juberian. The screen shot is of Juberian with his shirt off, in the middle of the street with a large crowd of people, many who are sitting in the middle of the street with the intention to block the street. I emailed the still image to Officer Craig Taylor. I wrote in the subject line: Do you see the guy who threw the rock at you? Officer Craig Taylor replied: The one without the shirt.

I will print off the email and inventory it.

On 06-26-2014, I will use my WCCO video copies to burn another set of copies for the County Attorney.

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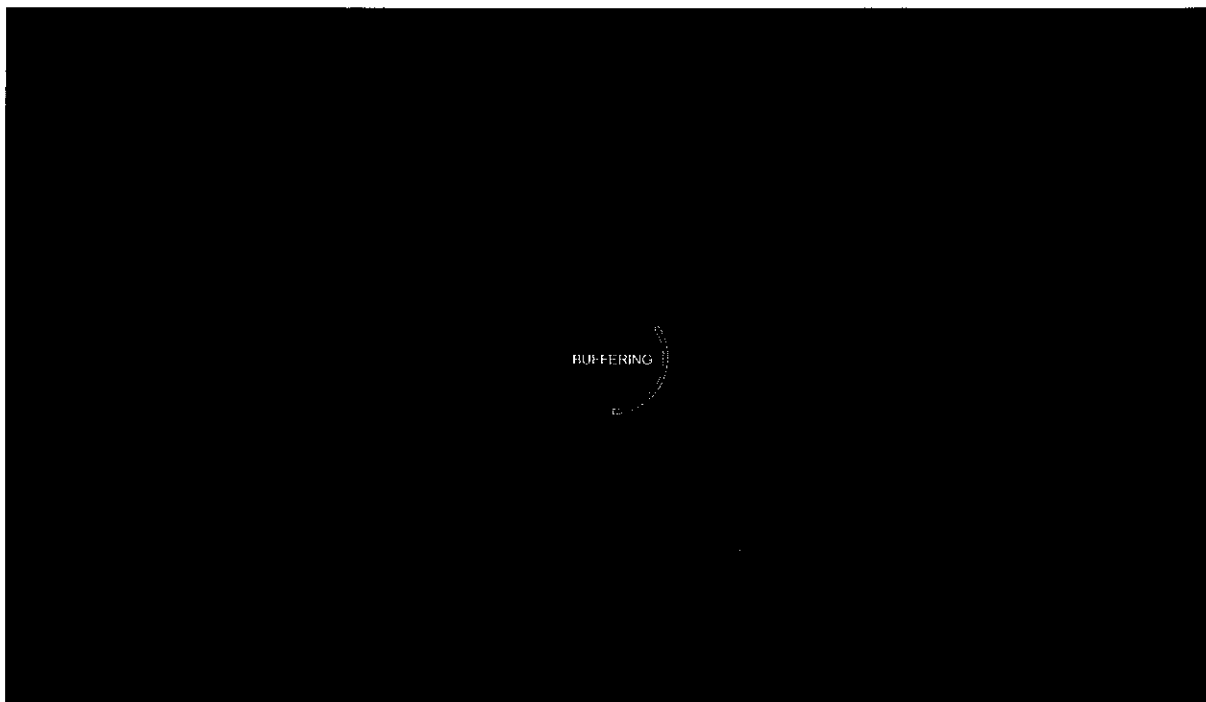
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U of M: No tolerance for bad behavior after championship

MINNEAPOLIS -- University of Minnesota leaders are warning students they'll have no tolerance for bad behavior Saturday night after the Gopher men's hockey game against Union College.

After the Gophers won the semifinal Frozen Four game against North Dakota on Thursday, fans converged on Dinkytown.

They got rowdy, throwing bottles, jumping onto a police car and damaging property.

Police used some chemical irritants to break up the crowd. Initial reports said about 100 were actually causing the trouble, and the rest were just watching.

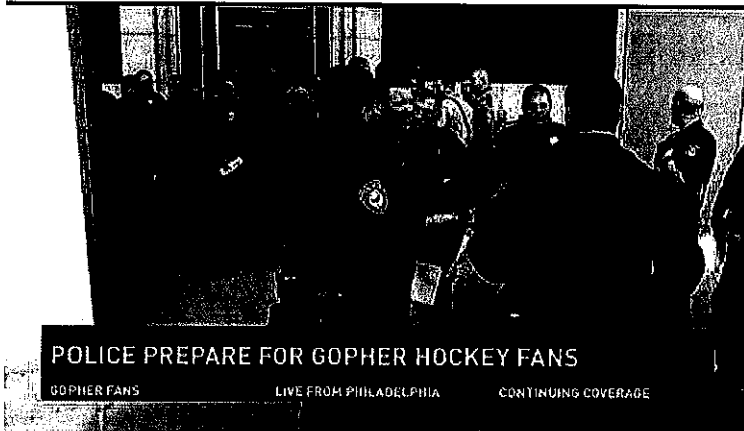
University Vice President Pam Wheelock said if things escalate this time around, onlookers should leave.

"There are no bystanders or spectators in a riot or a disturbance," Wheelock said. "If you are here, you are part of the incident, and you are subject to arrest."

Nine university students were arrested for disorderly conduct ([/story/news/crime/2014/04/11/dinkytown-arrests-hockey-celebration/7612209/](http://www.kare11.com/story/news/crime/2014/04/11/dinkytown-arrests-hockey-celebration/7612209/)) and unlawful assembly after the North Dakota game. The incident was over by 1:30 a.m., Wheelock said. No one was seriously injured, but a couple of officers did go to the hospital.

Police are gearing up for more potential disturbances Saturday. Wheelock said about 300 law enforcement officers [officers-to-patrol-dinkytown-on-saturday-night/7618859/](http://www.kare11.com/story/news/local/2014/04/12/u-of-m-no-tolerance-for-bad-behavior-after-championship/7618859/) will be patrolling Dinkytown after Saturday's Frozen Four final.

"We've done our homework and have researched what's going on in other communities where they've had teams playing here," Minneapolis Police Spokesman John Elder. "And we've come up with contingency plans for just about everything that could come our way."

U: Cops will be out in force Saturday for hockey title game

In response to the rambunctious and at times destructive mayhem that erupted in Dinkytown after the Minnesota Gophers' NCAA semifinal hockey victory over archrival North Dakota, university President Eric Kaler told students Friday that a substantial law enforcement presence will be in place to stymie a repeat when the team plays Saturday night for the national championship.

Thursday night's unrest, a milder reprise of the Frozen Four mayhem in 2002 and 2003, drew police in riot gear as Gophers fans converged, with some climbing on light poles and cars and taking selfies as the crowd grew. According to social media reports, some were belligerent toward police officers as they arrived to disperse the crowd.

Minneapolis police said two of its officers were slightly hurt and required medical attention after helping quell the two hours of unrest that also left "an undetermined amount of public and police property" damaged. Nine students were arrested on misdemeanor charges.

"The actions of a few people in Dinkytown last night unfortunately marred the victory of our Gophers men's hockey team," Kaler wrote in an e-mail to students. "These actions are unacceptable and must not be repeated."

Kaler said that any similar outbreak of misbehavior Saturday after Minnesota's game against Union "will be met with zero tolerance."

The president said that campus and city police and "other law enforcement from across the metro area" will be on duty "to keep the peace and arrest suspects."

University Police Chief Greg Hestness said Friday afternoon that "planning for Saturday has been underway for two months."

In a statement, Minneapolis police said it hopes people "celebrate responsibly and lawfully" after the championship game.

"If celebrations escalate into criminal behavior, the MPD will act to ensure public safety and protect property," the statement continued. "Anyone told to disperse from an assembly that has been declared unlawful must immediately leave the area. Failure to do so may result in an arrest."

Hours before Kaler's e-mail, student Nathan Lyons, who watched dozens clamber on top of a squad car Thursday night, said, "Whether the Gophers win or lose, it's going to be out of hand."

Looking ahead to Saturday night, university leaders said Friday that students face the possibility of arrest even if they are doing no more than standing by and watching any unruliness.

"If you are here, you are part of the incident and you are subject to arrest," Pam Wheelock, vice president for university services, said during a Dinkytown street corner news conference.

Kaler said in his e-mail that if the situation is getting out of hand, "it's best for you and your friends to leave. In this era of social media, no one is anonymous."

Nine students were among those arrested, Wheelock said, and they face disciplinary hearings that could result in a range of punishment, from a warning to community service to suspension to expulsion.

At least five of the code's 21 defined disciplinary offenses could apply: disorderly conduct, stealing or damaging property, disruptive behavior, rioting and committing crimes. The code also cautions that violations, even they occur off campus, can draw university punishment.

Joining Wheelock and others Friday was student body President Mike Schmit, who said he was embarrassed by how his fellow students behaved and pleaded for calm Saturday.

"When the Gophers win the national championship tomorrow night, I encourage you to find a way to celebrate that doesn't include trashing Dinkytown."

An amendment to the code in 2003 added rioting specifically in response to the Dinkytown unrest in April, university spokesman Steven Henneberry said. The code was amended again in 2006 to ensure that misbehavior off campus and in connection with university events could also draw punishment, he said.

Minneapolis police spokesman John Elder said some students threw beer bottles and cans at officers and a couple of squad cars were damaged. One video showed several young men climbing on a squad car and jumping on its trunk, roof and hood.

Court and jail records Friday show up to 10 arrests in connection with the overzealous celebrating, with most or all being U students. Charges of disorderly conduct and unlawful assembly the most common of the misdemeanor violations. But the number arrested could rise, if police succeed in getting citizens to turn in incriminating evidence.

The department "is currently reviewing video footage and actively investigating last night's criminal behavior," a police statement issued Friday afternoon read. "We encourage witnesses who have video or other evidence that might be helpful to investigators to contact the Minneapolis police tip line at 612-692-TIPS (8477)."

In 2002 and 2003, when the Gophers won national hockey titles, police and emergency personnel dealt with unruly fans, arresting several people. They also dealt with vandals and many small fires in Dinkytown.

One of those busted in 2002 was then-student Tony Smith, now living in the Los Angeles area. Smith said Friday he wants to warn current students not to get carried away Saturday, win or lose.

"Party inside," said Smith, who had to pay \$5,500 for bringing down a light pole and perform many hours of community service picking up trash and working at a recycling center. "One thing leads to another, and you get caught up in the moment. ... It can embarrass yourself and your family."

Leading up to Thursday night's NCAA semifinal game in Philadelphia over a spirited rival in North Dakota, police initiated a door-knocking effort to alert residents to the potential for hockey-related misbehavior. Also, a universitywide e-mail was sent before the weekend addressing how students should comport themselves.

A 21-year-old Minnesota student was among those arrested, but she contends that she did nothing wrong. "I happened to be standing there," she said. "I was telling my peers that it was ridiculous that we were rioting over a hockey game."

Her most immediate concern, now that she posted \$78 bail early Friday and is out of jail, is to "make sure this doesn't affect my graduation in the spring," she said. "I just want to get as far away from Dinkytown as possible."

Things could have spiraled out of control if police hadn't shown up in large numbers, said Lyons. "It would have gotten out of hand," the student said. "The cop car would have been destroyed."

An hour after the action died down, U student Haley Larson said, she and others sat on the front steps of a Dinkytown house sharing videos from the night.

Student Kallie McBride said she saw police officers shoot paint pellets or tear gas at students. "People near me were hit," she said.

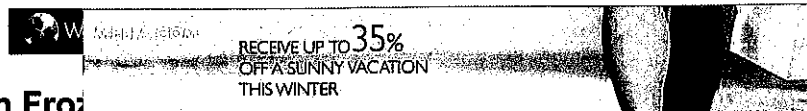
One group of students saw a trash can set on fire, posed for pictures next to it, and moments later ran as Minneapolis police fired a paint pellet at them.

"Did you see the little arsonist back there?" asked one of the officers. "He'll have green paint on him."

Streets were mostly calm by 1 a.m. Friday, though sporadic confrontations continued in the neighborhood around Dinkytown's business district.

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Gophers win Frozen Four Dinkytown celebrates

MINNEAPOLIS (KMSP) - The Gophers will play for the NCAA hockey championship Saturday night after a last-second, improbable goal lifted Minnesota over rival North Dakota in the Frozen Four semifinal.

THE HERO: Justin Holl, a senior defenseman for the Gophers, scored the game-winning goal. It was his first goal of the 2013-14 season.

THE SITUATION: The Gophers were shorthanded after Mike Reilly picked up a penalty in the final two minutes. North Dakota not only had the power play, but also the momentum. Sam Warring scored the game's first goal with 8:09 left in the third period, but North Dakota's Connor Gaarder tied the game just 32 seconds later.

THE GOAL: The Gophers brought the puck into the North Dakota zone with under 5 seconds left. Holl's shot went in with just 0.6 seconds left on the clock.

Hundreds of students and fans flooded the streets of Dinkytown, near the University of Minnesota campus, after Thursday night's win. People were jumping on police cars, setting fires, and throwing bottles and objects at police.

Minneapolis police said several people were arrested and an undetermined amount of public and police property was damaged. Two MPD officers needed to be taken to Hennepin County Medical Center for treatment.

The situation didn't reach the level of chaos experienced after the 2002 and 2003 post-championship riots. Since then, Minneapolis police and the university made changes to deal with rowdy crowds. Police are already planning for any incidents that may follow Saturday's championship game.

MESSAGE FROM MPD

The Minneapolis Police Department supports the University of Minnesota as we celebrate the Gopher's Mens Hockey Semi-Finals win. We hope that people celebrate responsibly and lawfully following the Gopher's appearance in the national championship game on Saturday night.

If celebrations escalate into criminal behavior, the MPD will act to ensure public safety and protect property. Anyone told to disperse from an assembly that has been declared unlawful must immediately leave the area. Failure to do so may result in an arrest.

Again, MPD supports and encourages lawful, responsible, and safe celebrations.

Dear Students,

We've had an exciting run of athletic achievements recently that bring great pride and lots of fun to the Twin Cities campus.

But, as our men's hockey team heads into the NCAA Frozen Four, we want to send a clear message: There will be zero tolerance for disruptive behavior or property damage. The University's Student Conduct Code applies to students on and off campus, and specifically prohibits destructive behavior in connection with a University event, such as a victory or loss by one of our teams.

When the Gopher men win the NCAA Hockey Championship there will be great cause to celebrate. We are all for having fun and for honoring our student-athletes. But remember you are University of Minnesota students and Golden Gophers.

If you are so moved, celebrate your Gopher spirit responsibly and safely, and make sure your actions reflect your pride in our University and our student-athletes.

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19 arrested in Dinkytown fray after Gophers' Frozen Four loss

Hundreds of Gophers fans and young people poured out of the bars of Minneapolis' Dinkytown neighborhood and onto the streets Saturday night after the University of Minnesota men's hockey team's loss in the NCAA Frozen Four championship game, in a repeat of the havoc two nights earlier.

About 9:45 p.m. -- roughly a half-hour after the game ended -- young people moved from sidewalks out onto the streets, chanting "USA!" and jumping, hurling profanities at police officers and throwing rocks and bottles.

Some lay in the intersection of Fourth Street Southeast and 14th Avenue Southeast.

Police formed a line, warned the crowd about unlawful assembly, and ordered them to disperse or be arrested. A helicopter hovering overhead repeated the warning.

Roughly a half-hour later, police forces had pushed much of the crowd back into residential areas west and north of Dinkytown, sometimes using pepper spray.

There were reports of officers shooting rubber pellets and beanbags to target the most unruly.

"With all the sirens and helicopters, it felt like a war zone," said recent U grad Austin Duket, 22, who ventured out after the game to see what the crowds would do. "There shouldn't be riots right now. We didn't even win."

His housemate, U senior James Anderson, 22, said Saturday night that the mayhem might have been anticipated.

"After Thursday, (the riots) were an event. People were like, 'You guys want to go to the riot on Saturday?' "

Minneapolis police posted a tweet about 1:30 a.m. Sunday saying at least 19 people were arrested, there were at least two incidents of arson and an undetermined amount of property damage. No officers were injured.

Police scanner reports stated officers were arresting people who used "assaultive behavior" and were damaging property.

About 10:45 p.m., several people could be seen tearing down a 14th Avenue and Sixth Street sign. They then waved it around and used it as a spear to break the windows of a parked Chevrolet Lumina.

Once the crowd began to disperse from the heart of Dinkytown, police shone

spotlights on big groups of people within a six-block radius of Fourth Street Southeast and 14th Avenue Southeast.

Minneapolis police spokesman John Elder said Sunday that more information regarding specific details on the incident will be released early in the week.

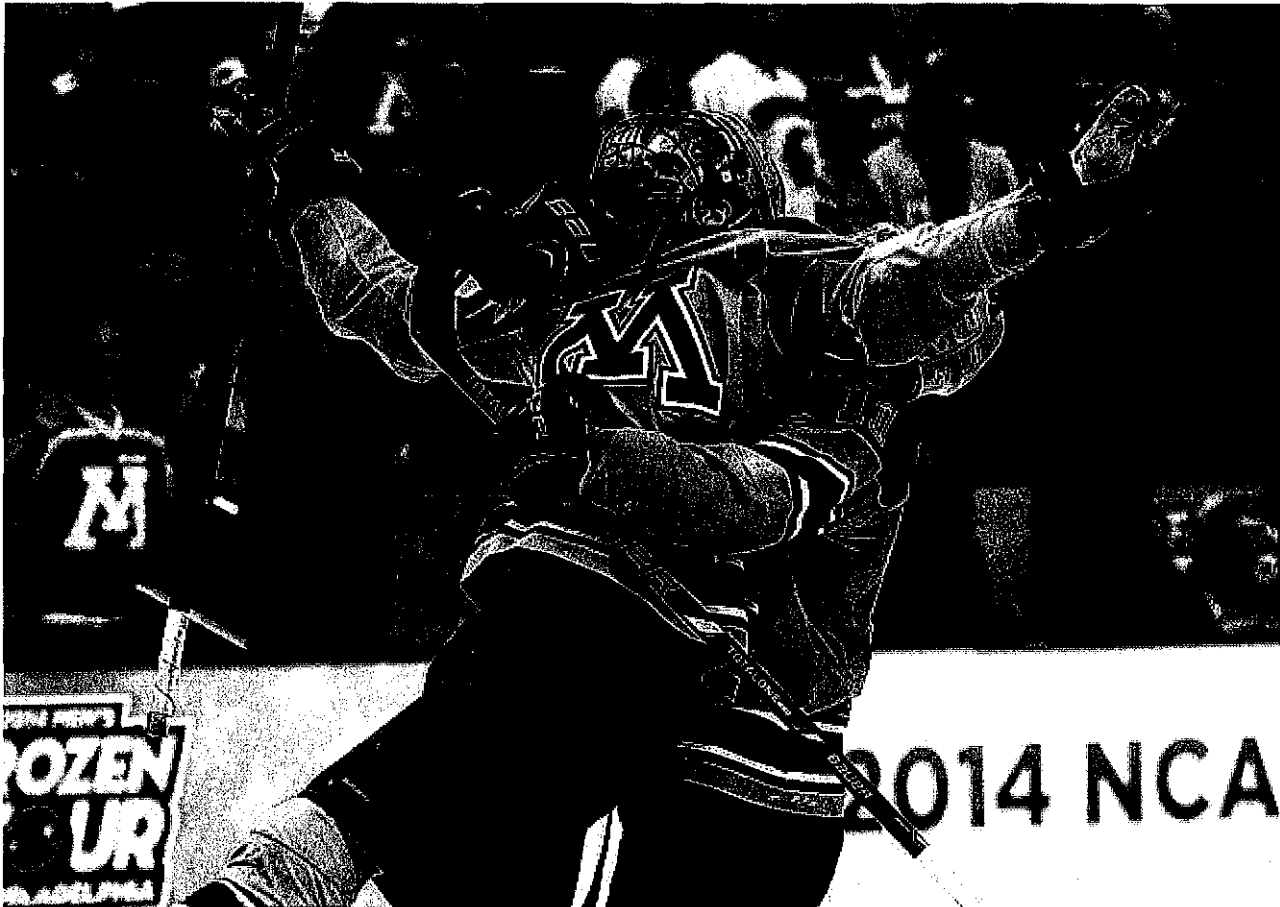

Gophers beat UND in Frozen Four semis; riot police break up Dinkytown fracas

Police in riot gear broke up a rowdy crowd in Dinkytown last night who spilled into the streets after a dramatic last-second win by Minnesota's men's hockey team in the Frozen Four semifinals.

The Gophers scored a shorthanded goal with less than a second left to defeat the University of North Dakota and go to this year's college hockey championship game. The Gophers and UND played in Philadelphia at the Wells Fargo Center.

Fans spilled into the streets near 4th and 14th Street southeast about 10 p.m., according to Minneapolis police spokesman John Elder.



Almost a dozen fans jumped on a police car, threw bottles and cans, shot off fireworks and climbed a traffic light as officers from the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis police, the East Metro SWAT team and the State Patrol gathered to disperse the crowd.

The Minneapolis fire department also responded to a small fire in the area, and a State Patrol helicopter also responded to help watch over the scene.

Initial reports indicated more than 100 people were involved as hundreds of others stood by and watched.

"There was a massive presence of students who failed to obey lawful commands," said Minneapolis police spokesman John Elder. "We had less than a dozen arrests."

Police sealed off the blocks from 13th to 15th Avenue and University to 5th Street SE.

The crowd dispersed early this morning. There were no reports of serious injuries, although scanner traffic indicated one police officer suffered a broken ankle.

The Gophers will play in the final against Union College on Saturday night. Union beat Boston College 5 to 4 yesterday to make its first appearance in the Division I championship game.

The University of Minnesota men's hockey team last won the national championship in 2003, which also sparked off rioting in Minneapolis. Police arrested 27 people in that disturbance, including a dozen felonies.

Police said earlier this week that they were preparing for unrest following the game against the Gopher's longtime rival from Grand Forks. University of Minnesota president Eric Kaler sent an email to U students on Tuesday saying the school would have "zero tolerance" for another riot following this year's hockey tournament.

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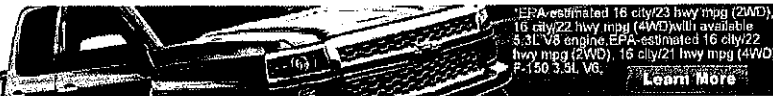

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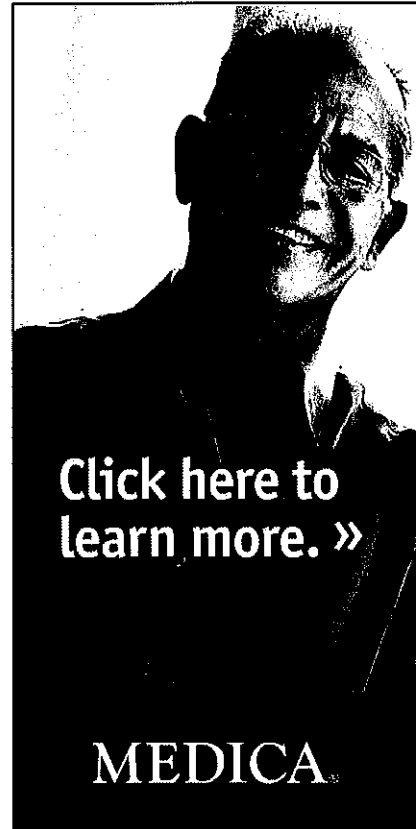

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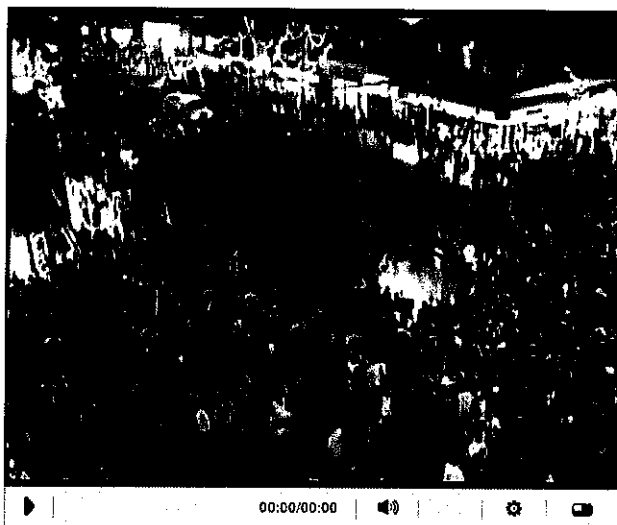
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MINNEAPOLIS (WCCO) — University of Minnesota officials are hoping that the Gopher hockey team has success in the Frozen Four, and calm on campus.

Just last night, Kentucky won the NCAA basketball championship, and violence broke out on the streets. Dozens were arrested and one man was injured by gunfire.

Now the university is laying out plans in the event the Gophers win the NCAA hockey title, hoping to avoid the violence of the past.

"We have a plan in place, and we will have a significant presence," said Lt. Bruce Jensen of the Minneapolis Police Department. "Make no mistake, we are prepared."

The university, Minneapolis Police and other law enforcement agencies are working together to avoid what happened in 2002 and 2003, when championship celebrations turned into ugly riots.

"A lot of visibility," said University Police Chief Greg Hestness, describing his department's preparation. "Frankly, interacting with students in a non-confrontational basis, in hopes that they can have a good time, but there's enough police present there so it doesn't reach a critical mass of insanity like it did last time."

They'll have better communication between agencies this time, and students have already been warned that rioting is covered by the student conduct code, even if it happens off campus.

"We know that students don't want to mar their record with police citations," said Vice Provost of Student Affairs Jerry Rinehart. "But they also don't want to jeopardize their relationship with the University. We want to make sure they're aware that that could happen to them."

While they're cheering for more success on the ice, they're also hoping for calm on campus.

"There's a point at which behaviors are criminal at one point," said Chief Hestness. "And they also really reflect badly on the University and frankly overshadow the accomplishments of the team."

In other words, they want to add another championship to the university's trophy case without adding another black mark to its reputation.

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They'll increase patrols for the semifinals on Thursday, with a much larger presence if the Gophers make it to the championship on Saturday night.

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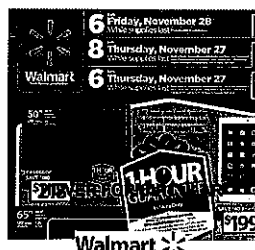
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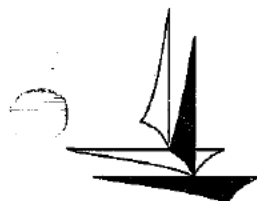

Jason,

- 1) Those 3 officers were not the only officers working downtown that night. Everyone who worked the Frozen 4 detail eventually ended-up working downtown bar close. However, we were split up for a period of an hour to an hour & half while one group stayed on the U campus until they were also released. They joined us after driving from the U of M into downtown.
- 2) We were never officially assigned to downtown. We were assigned to the Frozen 4 detail but were requested to assist downtown by Sgt. Herron and eventually released from the U of M by Lt. Stoll. At this moment, I don't remember the exact time the first group was released to head downtown since it was not a planned event. My rough estimate would be 0000-0030. I do remember that Officer Smith, Officer Madich and [REDACTED] were part of the first mounted group sent downtown.
- 3) Officers do not complete patrol logs for their shift.
- 4) I was the supervisor of the group that included all 3 of the Officers you listed when we arrived downtown initially. However, I frequently break my mounted teams up based on horses not necessarily people. Thus, I look at horse strengths and which horses work best together and break my team down accordingly. At this moment, I do not remember how the team got broken down that night and if we split and worked with a portion of the 2nd mounted team that arrived just before bar close.

On Mounted our assignments, partners and locations can change within an evening based on specific events occurring and horse reactions and abilities. Thus, within an evening teams can get split or partners interchanged to accomplish our task.

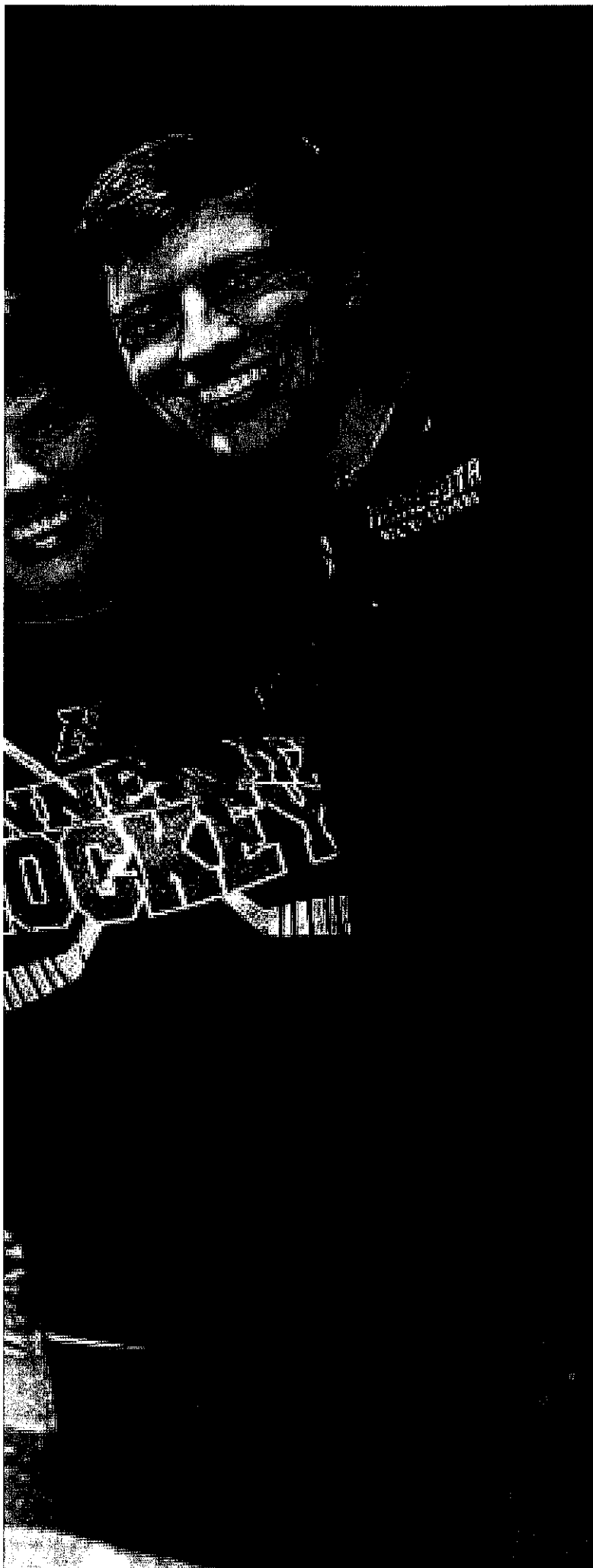

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5-306 USE OF FORCE – REPORTING AND POST INCIDENT REQUIREMENTS (08/17/07)

Any sworn MPD employee who uses force shall comply with the following requirements:

Medical Assistance:

As soon as reasonably practical, determine if anyone was injured and render medical aid consistent with training and request Emergency Medical Service (EMS) if necessary.

Supervisor Notification and CAPRS Reporting Requirements

-No CAPRS Report Required.

Unless an injury or alleged injury has occurred, the below listed force does not require a CAPRS report or supervisor notification.

- Escort Holds
- Joint Manipulations
- Nerve Pressure Points (Touch Pressure)
- Handcuffing
- Gun drawing or pointing

-CAPRS Report Required – No Supervisor Notification required.

The following listed force requires a CAPRS report, but does not require supervisor notification.

- Takedown Techniques
- Chemical Agent Exposures

-CAPRS Report Required- Supervisor Notification Required.

All other force, injuries or alleged injury incidents require both a CAPRS report and supervisor notification. The sworn employee shall remain on scene and immediately notify a supervisor by phone or radio of the force that was used.

- Supervisors shall not conduct a force review on their own use of force. Any other supervisor of any rank shall conduct the force review. (04/16/12)
- A CAPRS report entitled "FORCE" shall be completed as soon as practical, but no later than the end of that shift. A supplement describing the use of force incident in detail shall be completed and entered directly into the CAPRS reporting system (no handwritten force reports). Employees shall ensure that all applicable force portions of the CAPRS report are completed in full.
- Sworn employees shall complete a CAPRS report entitled "PRIORI" for all incidents in which a person has a prior injury, or prior alleged injury, and there is actual physical contact or transportation by the police.

5-105 PROFESSIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT (A-D)

10. Employees shall not use indecent, profane or unnecessarily harsh language in the performance of official duties or in the presence of the public.
