Public Data

Officers responded to a ROBBERY in the area of Emerson Av. N. in the 3500 block, suspects ran westbound through the yards after the robbery. Several males were seen running at this same time from the east through the yards to the west and to a waiting car parked at 3510 Fremont and get in. Officers stopped the males and the vehicle, recovered a firearm and detained all.

A separate CCN (SUSPV) was acquired for this CCN #16-342864 and affiliated with the listed address of 3510 Fremont Av. N, officers linked the ROBBERY Case to CCN #16-342771, and to the 3519 Emerson Av. N. address.

AP1 and AP2 were arrested out of the car just after they and another male were seen and heard running back to the SUSPV, the remaining males that were already in the car were positively ID'd by officers and the vehicle they were in run was checked. The vehicle came back with a COPS ALERT out of Brooklyn Center, the vehicle was wanted (Towed / Held) for a robbery in that city.

2 Males were booked into JDC via intake at the Minneapolis Juvenile Unit, all evidence was PI'd, the wanted vehicle was towed and held per instructions. Sgt. Suchta, okay'd the PC for the weapons arrests.



OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED TO AN AGG. ROBBERY (CCN #16-342771) IN THE 3500 BLOCK OF EMERSON AV., REMARKS FROM THE CALL WERE THAT A WITNESS/NEIGHBOR WATCHED MALES PULL A GUN ON THE NEIGHBORS WIFE AND ROBB/ATTEMPT TO ROBB HER PLACING THE GUN TO HER HEAD. JUST AFTER THE ROBBERY AND WHILE THE CALLER WAS CALLING 911, THE SUSPECTS WERE THEN SEEN STANDING ON THE PORCH OF 3519 EMERSON AV. N. BY WITNESS/NEIGHBOR WHICH IS AN ABANDONED ADDRESS, IT WAS LATER LEARNED THAT AT THIS SAME TIME A CALL HAD BEEN PLACED TO A PIZZA DELIVERY DRIVER THAT HAD JUST ARRIVED TO DELIVER A PIZZA TO 3519 EMERSON AV. N., THE ABANDONED HOUSE. AS OFFICERS INITIALLY ARRIVED, THE MALES WERE SEEN RUNNING DOWN THE SOUTH SIDE OF 3519 EMERSON AV. N. TOWARD THE WEST. OTHER OFFICERS WERE COMING THROUGH THE YARDS FROM THE WEST BETWEEN 3510 FREMONT AV. N. AND THE HOUSE JUST TO THE NORTH OF THAT 3510 FREMONT AV. N. ADDRESS, AS THE OFFICER WAS COMING THROUGH THE YARDS FROM THE WEST, HE SAW THREE MALES RUN FROM THE EAST AND OUT NEAR SOME BUSHES AND TO THE BACK YARD OF 3510 FREMONT AV. N. AND GET INTO AN WAITING VEHICLE. THE ADJACENT HOUSE TO THE EAST WHERE THE MALES WOULD HAVE COME FROM WOULD HAVE BEEN 3519 EMERSON AV. N. AFTER STOPPING AND DETAINING SEVERAL PEOPLE INSIDE THE VEHICLE THE OFFICER SAW THEM RUN INTO, OFFICERS REMOVED TWO OF THE THREE MALES THAT HE SAW RUN FROM THE AREA OF 3519 EMERSON AV. N. AND GET INTO THE VEHICLE. TWO OF THE MALES GOT INTO THE VEHICLE THROUGH THE DRIVER'S AS IT APPEARED. BOTH OF THESE MALES WERE SITTING IN THAT SEAT, WHEN THOSE TWO MALES, LATER LISTED AS AP1 AND AP2 WERE REMOVED FROM THE VEHICLE AND THAT SEAT, A GUN WAS FOUND IN PLAINVIEW UNDERNEATH THEM. THE VEHICLE'S LICENSE PLATE WAS CHECKED THAT THE MALES WERE SEEN GETTING INTO AND FOUND INSIDE OF AND IT CAME BACK WITH A KOPS ALERT OUT OF BROOKLYNE CENTER FOR BEING INVOLVED IN ARMED ROBBERIES IN THAT CITY. AP1 AND AP2 WERE BOTH ARRESTED AND TRANSPORTED TO JDC VIA THE MINNEAPOLIS JUVENILE UNIT FOR INTAKE. THE GUN WAS P.I.D, A SHOW-UP WAS CONDUCTED ON SCENE WITH INCONCLUSIVE RESULTS. ALL PARTIES LOCATED INSIDE THE VEHICLE WERE LATER RELEASED AFTER ACQUIRING POSITIVE ID'S. PC FOR THE WEAPONS ARREST WAS RECEIVED FROM SGT. SUCHTA, BADGE #6995.

On 09/19/2016 at approximately 2206 hours I was working squad 433 with my partner Officer Fitch. My partner and I were dispatched to 3519 Emerson Av N on a Robbery in progress (16-342771). Remarks in the call said that the caller witnessed their neighbor getting robbed by a male with a gun.

My partner and I arrived in the area and first arriving squads aired that the possible suspect was seen running WB through the yard into the alley from 3519 Emerson Av N. Squad 493 and 425 then aired that they were out with a vehicle in the alley on the 3500 block of Emerson to Fremont Av N.

My partner and I then went to assist squad 425 in the alley with the vehicle. Officers then ordered the occupants inside the silver vehicle with MN plates 605-GWK to come out. After officers ordered the male later ID'd as AP1 [REDACTED] out of the vehicle, I heard one of the officers telling us that there is a gun on the driver seat. I then ordered the front seat passenger to exit out of the vehicle and then he was detained by officers.

After parties in the vehicle were taken out I cleared the vehicle and I saw that there was a large black revolver type handgun on the driver seat.

The vehicle was searched and no other weapons were found inside the vehicle. OT1 [REDACTED] was ID'd photographed and then released. OT2/ Johnson, Stephon 03/22/1998 was ID'd photographed and released. Photos will be uploaded to evidence.com.

Officers BWC were activated during the felony stop.

On 9/19/2016 at around 2206 hours I was working uniformed patrol in SQUAD 433 with my partner OFFICER CHANG. We had BWCs and were driving marked squad 461 p#76671. We were dispatched to 3519 EMERSON AV N on an ATTEMPT ROBBERY OF PERSON call. Remarks stated that the neighbor was held at gunpoint by males.

Upon arriving in the rear alley of the address, officers had multiple SUSPECTS inside of vehicle MN 605GWK at gunpoint. At gunpoint I ordered OT1/ [REDACTED] from the rear driver's side seat out onto the ground. I then secured OT1 in handcuffs, frisked him for weapons, and placed him in the rear of my squad car. OT2/STEPHON ALLEN ROBERT JOHNSON was placed in the rear of my squad car also. I turned on the squad MVR. I identified OT1 and OT2 by squad MDC. OT1 was listed as a runaway but had returned home and was not removed from the system.

After the call was over I released OT1 and OT2 to one of the parents on scene. OT1 and OT2 were photographed and the photos were later uploaded to evidence.com.

On 09/19/2016 at 2213hrs while working squad 425 with my partner Officer Williams we self-assigned to a Robbery of a person call at 3519 Emerson AV N case # 16-342771. The remarks from dispatch were as follows:

ACROSS ST FROM CLR'S HOUSE /STILL ON THE PORCH... CLR SAW M'S PULL A GUN ON NBR'S WIFE/ATTEMPTED TO ROB HER

When we arrived we met with other officers who stated that the suspects took off EB through the yards. I drove down the alley between Freemont AV and Emerson AV north of 35 AV N. When we got to 3510 Emerson AV N we met with Officer Tidgwell who had a vehicle with multiple people in it. I assisted in removing the A1, later identified as [REDACTED] who was sitting in the driver's seat of vehicle. Once he was secured in a squad car I removed A2, later identified as [REDACTED] who slid down from the center counsel between the drivers and passenger seat and was now sitting in the driver's seat. I handcuffed and placed him in a squad car. When I returned to assist officers I saw a large black revolver sitting in the driver's seat next to the center counsel pointing up. I let other officers know and watched the gun until the other occupants were removed.

Once all the occupants were removed I photographed the revolver where it was sitting. I then put on blue gloves and removed the revolver to render it safe. I was unable to remove the cylinder but could see enough to make sure there was no ammunition in the gun. On the barrel I it said "BLACK OPS" and reading the label on the side of the gun it stated it fires .177 ammunition. The serial number on the gun was [REDACTED].

A1 and A2 were transported to MPLS City Hall when we removed A1 and A2 I photographed them to show the clothing they were wearing at the time of the arrest.

I took additional photographs of the revolver to show the serial number and the name on the barrel. The photographs were uploaded using the Axon app.

The revolver and 5 cell phones that were removed from [REDACTED] 13.43 were property inventoried at MPLS city hall property inventory room.

Brooklyn Center was notified that MPLS towed [REDACTED] 13.43 and was being held for our weapons unit.

A1 and A2 were booked JDC for PC weapons.

On 09/19/2016 at 2206 hours, I was working marked squad 425 (13.82) with my partner Officer Rodin when we responded to a robbery of person call at 3519 Emerson Av North.

Upon arriving on Emerson Av North, I was informed by officers on scene that a possible male suspect fled on foot WB through the yards. A firearm was used in the robbery. I advised officers on scene that was would assist and check the area for the suspect who fled on foot.

My partner drove the squad NB in the alleyway between Emerson and Freemont Av North. As we approached 3510 Fremont Av North, I observed Officer Tidgwell run out towards the alleyway and then head toward a parked vehicle in the rear driveway of 3510 Fremont. I looked and observed several people inside of the vehicle later identified by 13.43

I ran over to the vehicle and assisted with holding the vehicle at gun point until other officers arrived on scene. The driver of the vehicle later identified as AP1 was removed from the vehicle and placed into handcuffs. I assisted with pat searching AP1 and placing him in the rear of squad 425. A total of five occupants were removed from the vehicle.

I identified AP1 and AP2 as AP1 and AP2 were placed in the rear of squad 425. AP2 stated he was sitting in the front middle on top of the arm rests. I later found out at a handgun was located inside of the vehicle on the driver's seat towards the middle arm rests. I ran the license plate and found an NCIC "COPS ALERT" on the vehicle for armed robbery. The hit is listed below. Ch. 7 contacted Brooklyn Center about the hit. The vehicle was later towed to the MPLS impound lot and held for weapons.

I am a licensed Minneapolis Police Officer with the State of Minnesota and currently assigned to the 4th Precinct Directed Patrol Unit. On today's date and time I was wearing a full Class D uniform.

On today's date and time, I heard dispatch air that a person was robbed at gun-point in the 3500 block of Emerson Avenue North. Paraphrased remarks from the call as added by the call taker are listed below:

When this call was dispatched, I started driving toward the call to back-up Squad's #423 and #425. I heard officers air that they were going to go and speak with the victim and would be on Emerson and in the alley.

I knew that 3510 Fremont Avenue North was the house where the [REDACTED] lived with their mother. I know that both males were or are on probation for an assortment of crimes to include violent crimes. Due to the proximity to this call to the [REDACTED] I responded from the west coming in on 36th Av. N. and turning southbound on Fremont Av. N. until I was just north of the [REDACTED] address where I pulled over and stopped on the east side of Fremont Av. N.

I quietly got out of my squad and began going through the yards between houses, one house to the north of 3510 Fremont Av. N. to be exact. As I got to the back yard of this house, a Pitbull ran out of the open garage door of this address toward me. I circled just to the north of the dog and continued toward the alley.

When I was just about to the alley, I could hear several male's voices talking in a somewhat hushed but hurried tone but could not make out anything other than, "...hurry...come on" and then I heard the bushes rustling just to the south of where I was standing and across the alley as I had paused to listen. I saw AP1, AP2 and OT2 come running from between garages and through some bushes and toward the rear of 3510 Fremont Av. N. Just a second later, I heard cars doors shut and then saw the brake lights of a vehicle come on as if someone was pushing on the brakes and getting ready to leave.

All of this was happening very quickly and very fluidly, as I saw and heard the three males run across the alley, I came out into the alley right after them and believe that they never saw or heard me. At the same time, I saw Squad #425 coming toward me from the south, they were headed north in the alley and this was Officers Williams and Rodin, Badges #7779 and #6075 and they were driving toward me as noted.

When I saw these two officers, I said nothing to them nor did I take my eyes off of where the three males just went which was toward a parked car. I was quiet because I did not want to alert the males in the vehicle and just waved for Officers Williams and Rodin to hurry and follow me into the yard of 3510 Fremont Av. N.

By now I had drawn my duty weapon from its holster and quietly walked up to the driver's side of an Oldsmobile, Avalon (13.43 [REDACTED]), this is silver, four door sedan and it was running. There were five males now inside this vehicle and I surprised them. The first male I spoke to and made contact with was, AP1 [REDACTED] (he was wearing red boots, dark colored pants and a dark colored hooded sweatshirt that stood out very well), he was sitting in the driver's seat and was very verbal and demanding answers from me immediately.

Next to him was AP2 [REDACTED] who was sitting up and on the center armrest between the two people in the front seats (AP1 [REDACTED] and OT3 [REDACTED] OT3 [REDACTED] was the other front seat passenger, OT1 [REDACTED] and OT2 Johnson, Stephon were both sitting in the back passenger seats of the vehicle and in fact OT2 Johnson, Stephon was the third person I saw running back across the alley from the east and get into the car, he entered the rear passenger side door behind the driver (AP1 [REDACTED] and that is where I found him.

Myself, Officer Williams and Officer Rodin, his partner, had the vehicle surrounded and we were giving verbal commands for people to do what we were telling them to do. I had said to start taking people out of the car starting with AP1 [REDACTED] as I had remembered hearing a description on the radio of a black male with red shoes and dark pants and a hooded sweatshirt to which AP1 [REDACTED] was wearing all of these items and fit that description to a "T".

By now I was standing in front of the vehicle looking at and watching all of the males in the car. I had told them to place their hands up and where I could see them and to keep them there. I asked Officer Rodin to take AP1 [REDACTED] out and to the ground and hand cuff him which he did. Next he removed AP2 [REDACTED] in the same fashion, laid him down, hand cuffed him and escorted him away just as he had AP1; by now I had asked via my portable radio for additional officers to the scene to help us out. The responding and assisting officers arrived very quickly and began helping us process this scene.

After Officer Rodin had removed AP2 [REDACTED] he alerted me to the fact that there was a gun lying in the front seat, I looked and saw a black semi-automatic revolver; it was later told to me that the gun was a .177 mm air pistol. Because I was standing in front of the car, I could not see inside of it onto the driver's seat initially to see the gun until I stepped forward and to the crease of the driver's door. Up until that point, I could see the hands of the remaining occupants but nothing lower than their raised hands, heads, faces and upper torsos.

By now other officers had arrived as noted and had taken OT1 and OT2 Johnson, Stephon out of the back of the vehicle. The only other person that was left in the car was OT3 [REDACTED] and he was still sitting in the front passenger's side seat. From the point that officers had removed AP1 and AP2 [REDACTED] from the front, OT3 [REDACTED] did not move. I walked over and directed OT3 [REDACTED] out of the vehicle through the front passenger's side door telling him not to move toward that gun or I would hurt him very badly and told him to go to the ground where I handcuffed him, I stood him up and frisked him for weapons, I walked him over to nearby officers and they took custody of him.

Officers were in the process of photographing the suspect vehicle and recovering the gun by this point, I was told about that same time that the vehicle was in fact wanted in relationship to robberies in Brooklyn Center and that there was a KOPS ALERT on the vehicle when the officers ran the license plate.

Officers remained at the suspect vehicle parked behind 3510 Fremont Av. N. to finish checking and processing the suspect vehicle while I went to try to coordinate a "Show-up" with the victim to show that person the five males that we had detained. Also a MPLS K9 officer arrived on scene in an attempt to track the robbery suspects, please see MPLS K9 Officer Klahn report for details of the track.

All five detained males were systematically and individually removed from the squads that they were in. I had two officers assigned for every one suspect and the specific suspect was removed from handcuffs and escorted to the south end of the alley located on 35th Av. N. between Emerson and Fremont Av. N.

Again, systematically each suspect was walked up within twenty of so feet of the victim and the victim was given an opportunity to see the people we had detained and how they were dressed. Please see other officer's reports for details as they were in a position to speak with the victim.

I was told that the "Show-up" proved inconclusive, please see the reports of other officers for details on the show-up. Based on the facts that we had at that point, AP1 and AP2 were placed under arrest for WEAPONS possession and they were subsequently transported to Minneapolis Police Headquarters and to the Juvenile Unit for arrest processing and documentation and later transported to the Hennepin County JDC where they were

photographed in the clothing that they were wearing at the time and booked in.

I had requested that all of the remaining males be photographed in the clothing they were wearing at the time of the incident and detention and positively identified, once that was completed they (OT1, OT2 and OT3) were all released. I was later informed that the clothing that AP1 and AP2 were wearing was not confiscated by officers but that photographs as requested had been taken and downloaded.

The suspect vehicle with the KOPS ALERT out of Brooklyn Center was also asked to be photographed and it was later towed to the Minneapolis Police Impound Lot and there was a HOLD for the Minneapolis Police Weapons and Robbery Units placed up it. The vehicle was taken to the general impound lot as no further details were given in the KOPS Alert such as "forensics garage", etc. and officers on scene did call and notify Hennepin County per instruction in the KOPS Alert of the fact that we were towing it to our Impound Lot.

While some officers cleared to respond to other calls, the officers from Squad #411 remained on scene in the alley behind 3510 Fremont AV. N. to wait for the tow per policy. As I had pulled out of the south end of the alley behind this address, there was a group of about five to seven people, all were males except for one female that ID'd herself as a sister to one of the males we had detained. The other males claimed to be "relatives" of the males we had detained, but they would not clarify their relationships and were hostile.

This group of people as noted were very hostile and belligerent; they were swearing using vulgar language and they were using racially motivated language towards officers. They were aggressive and were clearly angry. Random males would ask who we had detained and why, they wanted to know why we had the car and why we weren't releasing it. One male had his "mother" on a cell phone and I could hear him yelling at her and her yelling back at him. He kept demanding that I talk to his "mother" and explain to her why her car was getting towed.

I explained to him, the group and the female multiple times why we were there, why we got called there, that the vehicle was wanted in connection to a robbery/s in Brooklyn Center and that it was being towed. I explained to the male speaking to his mother that they could call the Minneapolis Police Robbery Unit tomorrow during business hours for details and the disposition on the car.

I explained all of this to them a couple of times, my attempts fell upon deaf ears and upon people that only wanted to yell, scream, holler and make derogatory comments towards us so I stopped explaining. OT2 [REDACTED] and OT1 [REDACTED] had walked back up toward the scene and were part of this hostile crowd; they and a couple other males had entered the south end of the alley and had started walked toward us. I approached them and told them to leave or be arrested immediately, OT2 [REDACTED] brought up the last time that I had contact with him and he made some comments about me "beating his a**" in the attic of his house when I located him hiding. I had been there with my partner and Hennepin County MAVI PO Michael O'Malley, we were looking for OT2 [REDACTED] and his brother AP2 [REDACTED] as they were both in violation of conditions of their probation and had warrants, their mother PG2 [REDACTED] lied to me and my partners about the location of her sons, I arrested her then and booked her into HCJ at that time and her sons into JDC. The angry group did leave the alley and crossed over the street as I told them to do.

Please see the other officer's reports for details of their actions, evidence dispositions and any other details I didn't cover, again this case was linked with CCN #16-342771 which was the precipitating case to this one located at 3519 Emerson Av. N., an Aggravated Robbery at Gunpoint. I conferred with Sgt. Suchta and briefed him on the details of the incident; he gave PC for the WEAPONS arrests of AP1 and AP2 in this case. No force was used during this incident and no one requested any type of medical treatment or evaluation as a result of injury, nor did anyone complain of injury. If it was not included prior, please HOLD the weapon for finger print and DNA analysis per departmental policies and procedures. This ends my supplemental report.

On 9/21/2016 I went to JDC to speak with AP2 [REDACTED] regarding this incident. The vehicle in which AP's and OT's were located had a KOPS Alert out of Brooklyn Center so I had a Brooklyn Center Investigator with me during the interview (Brooklyn Center PD Detective Valleau). A2 [REDACTED] was read a Miranda Advisory and the following is a non-verbatim summary of the audio-recorded interview (see audio for full detail):

A2 was in the area of the incident with OT2/JOHNSON and OT3 [REDACTED] when he saw the vehicle of A1 [REDACTED] (incident vehicle) running in the alley behind his house. A2 got into the vehicle and started playing music. A2 was seated in the driver's seat of the vehicle, OT3/ROBINSON was seated in the front passengers seat, and OT2 [REDACTED] was seated in the back. A short time later, A1 [REDACTED] and OT1 [REDACTED] came running up to the vehicle, knocking on the window telling A2 to open the door. A2 unlocked the doors and A1 [REDACTED] got into the driver's seat, and OT1 [REDACTED] got into the back seat. When A1 [REDACTED] got into the vehicle, A2 felt and saw the handgun being put between the driver's seat and the center console by A1 [REDACTED]. A2 advised that he has been in possession of the gun that was recovered from the scene and his DNA will be present on the weapon. DNA gave verbal consent to collect a DNA sample. The sample was collected and property inventoried.

The interview was concluded and the audio-interview was burned to a disc to be property inventoried.

On 9/21/2016 I went to JDC to speak with A1 [REDACTED] regarding this incident. The vehicle in which AP's and OT's were located had a KOPS Alert out of Brooklyn Center so I had a Brooklyn Center Investigator with me during the interview (Brooklyn Center PD Detective Valleau). A1 [REDACTED] was read a Miranda Advisory and the following is a non-verbatim summary of the audio-recorded interview (see audio for full detail):

A1 identified himself by information provided in the report with the nickname of "Lil Ant" or "Ant." A1 first advised that he was in the house with the OT's and AP2 [REDACTED] and wanted to leave but his car (605GWK), which was parked in the rear of the house, had a dead battery. The mom of one of the friends gave the car of A1 [REDACTED] a jump start. A1 and OT1 [REDACTED] were waiting in the running car when A2 [REDACTED] OT2/JOHNSON, and OT3/ROBINSON came up. A1 went into the house to use the bathroom. When he came back to the vehicle, A2 [REDACTED] was in the driver's seat of the vehicle. A1 got into the driver's seat and A2 [REDACTED] moved to the center console. The police then arrived and removed parties from the vehicle. A1 was shown pictures from Evidence.com that officers took of his clothing from the night of this incident (dark blue sweatshirt, dark blue sweatpants, and red boots). A1 advised that that was his clothing from the night of the incident.

A1 then changed his story to OT3/ROBINSON called someone to set up a robbery. A1 and OT1 [REDACTED] were sitting on the porch of an abandoned house waiting for the target of the robbery to arrive. A1 then tried to advise that there was another party with red shoes who was present who ran off to do a robbery. The unknown party then ran off, ran back toward them, but continued to run off.

A1 then changed his story to he and OT1 [REDACTED] were waiting to do the robbery. When the target of the robbery arrived, OT1 [REDACTED] advised the target that they had to go to the back of the house to get something, walked around the back, and never went back to the front of the house or had contact with the target.

A1 agreed to provide a DNA sample. The sample was collected and property inventoried.

A1 then changed his story again. A1 advised that he and OT1 [REDACTED] were walking up and down the alley "poking" (robbing). A1 and OT1 [REDACTED] were walking up to do the robbery of a victim who pulled up behind his house in the alley with OT1 [REDACTED] in possession of the gun. OT1 [REDACTED] was scared because he did not have a jacket on so he handed the gun to A1. A1 approached the male, noticed the male see A1 holding the gun, didn't say anything to the male, and then walked off with no proceeds. It should be noted that the robbery report (MPLS CCN: 16-342771) indicated that A1 approached the victim in the rear alley, a fight ensued, and A1 fled prior to removing any loss. A1 and OT1 [REDACTED] got back to the vehicle and A1 handed A2 [REDACTED] the gun prior to everyone getting in the car.

The interview was concluded and the audio-file was burned to a disc to be property inventoried. I went to JDC intake and recovered the outer clothing of A1 (dark blue sweatshirt, dark blue sweatpants, and red boots). I submitted a work order to have the weapon and other items processed for DNA and fingerprints. Once the evidence is returned I will have the evidence brought to the BCA for examination.
