



5 Q: OK. The recorder is on. This is a tape-recorded statement of Officer Peter Brazeau  
6 on 6/1/2017 at approximately 1400 hours in the MPD IAU Office being interviewed by  
7 Sergeant Brian Sand, uh, and Todd Sauvageau. Also, present is Minneapolis, uh, Police  
8 Federation Representative, Bob Kroll, and Attorney, uh, Beck...Kevin Beck. This is  
9 regarding IAU (OPCR) Case #16-22845.

10  
11 What is your full name?

12 A: It's Peter Brazeau.  
13

14 Q: And what is your present rank and work assignment?

15 A: I'm a Police Officer, and I'm assigned to 13.43 right now.  
16

17 Q: What is your employee number and date of appointment?

18 A: My employee number is 000750, and I believe my date of appointment or graduation  
19 from the Academy was November 28<sup>th</sup> of 2014.  
20

21 Q: You are being ordered to give a complete and truthful statement pertaining to the  
22 scope of your employment or fitness for duty. It is a compelled statement pursuant to  
23 MPD Policy and Procedure.  
24

25 Under the Garrity Decision, any statement provided in this investigation cannot be used  
26 in a criminal proceeding against you, except in the case of alleged perjury. However,

3 called to explain the circumstances regarding this allegation?

4 A: Yes, I do.

5  
6 Q: What was shift, uh, hours and assignment on 12/28/2016?

7 A: I was assigned to [REDACTED] 13.43 and the hours are [REDACTED] 13.43 - Personnel Data  
8

9 Q: And who was your partner?

10 A: Officer Alex Brown.

11  
12 Q: All right. Tell me, uh...give me a background of your training and experience  
13 regarding use of force.

14 A: I was trained in the Minneapolis Police Academy on use of force. I went through the  
15 Minnesota, uh, Technical Law Enforcement Licensing Certificate program and I go to  
16 annual Defensive Tactics Refresher Training.  
17

18 Q: Do you have any outside, uh, training on use of force?

19 A: No, I do not.  
20

21 Q: OK. You first encounter Mr. Bern (Mr. Bern Day) regarding a fight call at 0200 at the  
22 Gay 90's. Take me through that, uh, encounter with him.

23 A: When we arrived, uh, he was on the patio. I could hear him yelling "south side,"  
24 even as we were pulling up in the car. When I got out, he was inside the patio of the  
25 Gay 90's. I got out of the passenger side of the squad car. He approached me. I could  
26 see that his face, hands, shirt were covered in blood. Um, I know he wanted to shake  
27 my hand, but, because he was covered in blood, I told him I do not want to shake his  
28 hand. I walked around to the front entrance of the patio. I heard a bouncer tell me or  
29 say that he was not drinking here and they didn't know who this guy was. He hadn't  
30 been there all night. Uh, I found a black hat and a pair of glasses, which I asked, uh, Mr.  
31 Day if they belonged to him. He said they did and I returned them to him. I can't  
32 remember if it was my partner or I who asked for his ID, and instead of pulling out his  
33 ID, he pulled out a wad of cash and then threw it on the ground. I recall my partner  
34 went and picked up some of the cash for him, and then he handed me his wallet where I  
35 got his, uh, ID out of it and handed it to another officer, who ran it and said that he  
36 came back clear. I recall that Day was staring...he was facing south staring at the  
37 intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> and Hennepin, um, saying something about somebody wanted to fuck  
38 him up or he wanted to fuck somebody up. And I asked him how he was getting home,  
39 where he was going. He said the south side and he was walking. I asked him several  
40 times if he wanted police service or medical attention. He declined all police service, all  
41 medical attention. I also saw a jacket on the outside railing of the patio and asked him if  
42 he was going to be able to...you know, if it was his jacket and he jumped right over the

1 railing, picked the jacket up, and looked like he wanted to go to 5<sup>th</sup> and Hennepin. So, I  
2 sent him down to 4<sup>th</sup> Street and told him to walk that way, so that way he could  
3 deescalate and he wouldn't be involved in another confrontation.

4  
5 Q: What was his demeanor like or was he under the influence of anything?

6 A: He appeared to be intoxicated.

7  
8 Q: OK. So, then he-, he walks away. Why didn't you take him in protective custody at  
9 that time?

10 A: He had a plan for how he wanted to get home. He had said he did not want any  
11 medical attention. He was able to say where he was going. He could hop the railing  
12 better than I could, so, obviously, he was able to take care of himself and wasn't in need  
13 of any medical attention at that time.

14  
15 Q: OK. So-, so, then what happens after he-, he is sent on his way?

16 A: I recall watching him walk down east on 4<sup>th</sup> Street towards Nicollet. Uh, my partner  
17 and I got in our squad, cleared the call, drove around the block. As I recall, we drove  
18 down 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Marquette, Marquette south to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, and as we were driving  
19 west on 5<sup>th</sup> Street, I could hear somebody yelling cause we had the windows cracked in  
20 our car, if I remember correctly. Um, once we got to 5<sup>th</sup> and Nicollet, I saw Mr. Day. He  
21 was walking south from 4<sup>th</sup> Street on Nicollet and I watched him take his shoulder and  
22 bump into one person walking by, like he was shoulder checking like he was trying to  
23 start a fight like a chest bump. I recall that person looked like they didn't want anything  
24 to do with it and they stepped away and quickly continued north on Nicollet Mall. I  
25 watched Mr. Day walk into a second person, again, doing the shoulder check thing and I  
26 recall watching him try and spit on that person.

27  
28 Q: OK. So, now, you decide to take...or what-, what was your-, your decision next?

29 A: Because he was intoxicated, he was able to care for himself. But, now, he's being a  
30 danger to other people cause he's trying to start fights, he's assaulting and spitting on  
31 them, um, committing disorderly conduct and at least 5<sup>th</sup> degree assault. Due to his  
32 level of intoxication, I...we got out of the car. I told him immediately -- just like we're  
33 trained in Procedural Justice, it helps deescalate the situation to explain to him -- what's  
34 going on, where he's going, what's happening. So, I got out of the squad and said you're  
35 in protective custody, you're too intoxicated, starting fights with people, you're gonna  
36 go to the hospital.

37  
38 Q: OK. So, then you approach Mr. Bern. Then?

39 A: Uh, when I told him to turn around and put his hands behind his back, instead, he  
40 turned towards me, put his hands down by his waist, and started tensing up. At that  
41 time, my partner walked up behind him.

1 Q: Um, then what happened?

2 A: Then, without being ordered to, Mr. Day went prone on the ground. I-, I believe my  
3 partner told him to put his hands behind his back. He put his hands behind his back and  
4 we handcuffed him.

5  
6 Q: OK. We'll just go through video here to the incident and stuff. [video plays in  
7 background] Why did you say...or I know that, uh, Brown...Officer Brown said he was  
8 boring and you kind of said, yes, you are. Why-, why did you think he was boring at that  
9 point?

10 A: He just laid down and sat on the ground. He didn't say anything before he was  
11 yelling "south side." He was all excited. I don't mind that he's boring at all. I-, I  
12 appreciated that at that point in time.

13  
14 Q: Were you expecting like him to fight at this point?

15 A: I was. Like I said, when I told him he was in protective custody, he turned around  
16 and clenched up, and he was in a fight earlier. I just watched him assault two other  
17 people as he was walking down the street. I fully expected him to fight.

1 Q: So, he, um...you give him an opportunity to get up and he can't get up?

2 A: Correct.

3  
4 Q: And then, you guys go to help him up?

5 A: Yes, I was actually bending over, like reaching over to help escort him or help him  
6 stand up, when he kicked me the first time.

7  
8 Q: Why did you decided to approach him from the front and not the rear as he was  
9 lying down?

10 A: I was actually on his side as I recall.

11  
12 Q: You were on the side, OK. And then, describe the kick, uh, that he did.

13 A: He was able to sit up, but not stand up, so his body was kind of in an "L" shape with  
14 his torso upright and his feet out in front of him. He rocked his upper back and I believe  
15 it was his left foot that kicked me square in the chest. You could hear it knock the wind  
16 out of me and knocked my body camera off me. And then, I watched the second...his  
17 other leg come up, like he was trying to kick me again, but I pushed that. I was able to  
18 push that foot out of the way.

19  
20 Q: And then, take me through what-, what you did next.

21 A: Then, I placed my knee on his chest and delivered three to four strikes to his face.

22  
23 Q: Why did you think that was the appropriate force to use?

24 A: Um, according to our training and response guide, he was committing active  
25 aggression because he did assault me. It's behavior that constitutes an assault. I am  
26 able to respond with anything up to the baton according to our Use of Force Matrix.  
27 Um, I chose stunning strikes because I didn't have the opportunity to pull my baton out  
28 and use it. I also didn't have the opportunity because he was still kicking at that time  
29 and he was continuing to try and attempt to assault me after he already did once. I  
30 couldn't grab his legs without being kicked again. I've seen numerous articles in the  
31 paper and the news where officers have been kicked in the face and lost their eyesight.  
32 I didn't wanna risk that to myself or my partner. Delivering three to four punches to his  
33 face, which is less force than the kick he used against me, was the best option I had at  
34 the time.

35  
36 Q: So, he was lying on his back handcuffed. What kind of a threat was he at that time?

37 A: He was obviously a great threat-, threat. Like I said, he kicked me, knocked the wind  
38 out of me, tried to kick me again. If he would have kicked me in the face or my partner  
39 in the face, we could have lost our eye, could have broke our jaw. I did mention before  
40 I've seen numerous articles where officers have been injured. Just because someone is  
41 in handcuffs doesn't mean that they're unable to assault you.

Q: And then, you said...how many punches did you deliver?

A: I believe three to four. I did not count.

Q: Why was three to four necessary instead of one? And you said they were stunning strikes?

A: Yes.

Q: So, why-, why was more than one punch needed?

A: Because he was continuing to kick. As soon as I felt that he was not kicking anymore, I ceased my strikes immediately. You could hear me on the video I aired for a supervisor for use of force review per policy and I also aired for an ambulance per policy.

Q: And then, uh, you tell him to get on the ground, but he was already on the ground?

A: That's an...it was an instinctive response to our... Like the way we've been trained is if someone strikes, you try and block or move out of the way of the kick if you can, deliver strikes, and you yell at them to get back or get on the ground. That was just my instinctive response from the training that I have received.

Q: Then, uh, did you tell medics what you did?

A: Yes. As I recall, I did.

Q: OK.

A: I believe I also told them that he was involved in a fight earlier at the Gay 90's, and when I ran into him before, he'd obviously been in a fight cause he had blood all over him.

Q: OK. All right. Anything else you can think of?

SERGEANT TODD SAUVAGEAU: No.

Q: Looking back, is there anything else you would have done differently in this case?

A: No, there is nothing else that I can think of to do. I haven't received any other training on dealing with this sort of incident.

Q: Are there any facts concerning this incident that you have knowledge of, but not yet disclosed?

A: I want to mention that when Officer Hillbo and Officer Cook came <sup>that</sup> ~~this~~ Mr. Day was still excited and possibly experiencing excited delirium. He was still assaultive. He was telling us that he was gonna fuck us up. It took all four of us -- my partner and I, plus Officer Hillbo and Cook -- to hold him down on the ground cause he kept kicking his legs. We did try and put him in the side recovery position, but because he was kicking we had to lay him back prone on his stomach alternating him back up, so we were trying to assist him as much as possible. When medics arrived, they...he was in such an excited and aggressive state that he had to be administered some of sort of sedative. And as I recall, the staff when he got to HCMC 13.384. They said 13.384.



On 12/29/2016 at approximately 0213 hours I was working Squad 131 in marked Squad 133 **13.82** with my partner Officer BROWN. We were on patrol in the area of 5th St S and Nicollet Mall when I heard a male yelling in the 400-block of Nicollet Mall.

My partner drove the squad north on Nicollet Mall from 5th St S and I saw a male, who I recognized from a previous Fight call at the Gay 90's (CCN: 16-465101) as A1/BERTH DAY, walking on the sidewalk. I saw A1 walk into another passerby walking on the sidewalk, and bump into the passerby like he was trying to start a fight. I saw A1 walk up to another person walk by, and spit towards the person walking by. Both passerbys left the area, walking quickly away from A1 like they did not want to get into a fight.

During CCN: 16-465101 I saw A1 standing in the patio of the Gay 90's yelling "south side" repeatedly. I saw that A1 had blood on his face and hands. A1 was asked for his ID, and attempted to give my partner cash. A1 threw the cash on the ground and I saw my partner pick it up and hand it back to A1. Staff at the Gay 90's said he was not drinking at their bar. I gave A1 a black hat and pair of glasses I found on the patio, which he said belonged to him. I saw a black jacket on the sidewalk in front of the patio, and asked A1 if it was his. A1 said it was his, jumped over the patio railing and walked north on Hennepin Ave S towards 4th St S. I saw A1 begin walking east on 4th St S from Hennepin Ave S. My BWC was activated during this CCN. I labeled it with CCNs: 16-465101 and 16-465119. During CCN: 16-465101 A1 said he did not want EMS or police assistance.

My partner stopped the squad, I got out, activated my BWC, and told A1 that he was in protective custody and to put his hands behind his back. A1 stopped walking and looked at me. A1 held his hands down by his waist and turned towards me like he was going to fight. I saw my partner walk up behind A1, then A1 laid down on the ground on his stomach and he was instructed to put his hands behind his back. A1 put his hands behind his back and I kneeled on his back and assisted my partner with handcuffing A1.

A1 said something similar to he can get up on his own, so I allowed him to attempt to get up on his own. I heard A1 then begin swearing at us and calling us "pussy ass niggers." A1 then kicked my BWC off my chest. A1 attempted to kick me again.

Because A1 was kicking me, I was unable to grab his legs without being kicked again, so I knelt on A1's upper chest to pin him to the ground and punched him in the face three to four times with a closed fist. I told A1 to get on the ground so that he would stop assaulting me. After I punched A1 three to four times he stopped kicking and stopped resisting, so I helped pin him to the ground with my knees. Once my partner and I had him pinned to the ground and he was no longer resisting, I aired for a supervisor and EMS.

Because A1 was spitting at other people walking by and was spitting while my partner and I were pinning him to the ground, I got a spit hood and placed it over A1's head.

I assisted my partner and other officers with holding A1's legs and torso to the ground until EMS arrived. Other officers and I attempted to roll A1 onto his side in the recovery position, but he kept moving his legs and I was afraid that he was going to kick me or other officers again. I helped alternate A1 between lying on his stomach and lying on his side. While A1 was on his side, he was grabbing at my partner and I, so I placed his hands in a wrist lock to prevent him from grabbing other officers or myself.

When EMS arrived, EMS sedated A1. I assisted EMS and other officers with loading A1 onto a stretcher.

I deactivated my BWC to speak with other officers. Sgt. SCHMID, arrived on scene and I advised him of the situation and the force I used.

I activated my BWC and rode with A1 to HCMC. I deactivated my BWC in the ambulance because A1 was handcuffed to the stretcher and was no longer combative.
