Description of Incident \* In front of the Gold Medal Park sign were FOUR police cars, one up on the grass, all of them with the lights blinking and one of the cars was blocking 2nd St. Seated on the ground in front of the sign were 3 black male youths. The police were going back and forth to their cars while two stood a few feet away from the kids. One police officer was yelling things at them like, "I don't care WHAT your name is. I have no way of knowing if you are a member of Al-Qaeda or not. I am NOT prejudiced because you are black. I don't care if you are green. If you break the law, I am going to get up in your face. OK, so you didn't have any drugs on you." After about 45 minutes, the kids were let go and the police left.



Complainant states after the youths were detained by officers for about 45 minutes, they were released.

On 08/15/14 at 2017 hours, I, Officer ARCHER, was working marked squad 850, vehicle p#1963. I was dispatched, along with other officers, to 1100 2nd St. So., Gold Medal Park, for report of a physical fight involving 6-8 individuals between the ages of 17-20 years old, who were black males.

Upon arrival, assisting squads stopped a group of six Somali males at the corner of 2nd St. and 10th Ave. I observed two of the Somali males walking away from the other group. I stopped the two males, who appeared to be grabbing onto each other. The two males were identified. One of the males was identified by the DVS website as Arrested Party #1/ALI MUSE(AP1). AP1 was found to have a misdemeanor warrant for Dakota County, warrant #201453669. AP1's warrant was confirmed through Dispatch. The other males who were stopped by assisting squads were released. AP1 was transported to HCJ and booked for the Dakota County Warrant.

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### **CASE OVERVIEW**

A citizen passing by, noticed a group of black youths in Gold Medal Park. This citizen made the initial 911 call because he believed they were fighting. Several squads responded to the situation. Officers involved in the call were Officer Guelcher, Officer Appledorn, Sgt. Erika Christiansen, and Park Officer John Archer. There were complaints from several citizens regarding the attitude and language used by the officers at the scene.

### SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

Based on a review of the evidence gathered during the OPCR investigation, the following occurred:

This investigator contacted the 911 caller, who confirmed making the complaint. However, when the squads responded he was no longer in the area. The primary Complainant Kittock , was on her deck and overheard the language of the officers, and viewed and heard their interaction with the youths. Complainant Miller was actually a ride along with Park Officer Archer. She exited the squad, and was standing in close proximity to the officers. She overheard the language of the officers firsthand. And she observed their demeanor in dealing with the youths. Complainant Vigil was walking his dog nearby, and overheard the language used by the officers in dealing with the youths.

Each Officer was interviewed by this investigator. Not one of the Officers stated that they heard any language similar to what the Complainant's put forth.

### DISCUSSION

Simply stated , this incident is a wholesale coverup by all the officers at the scene. Officer Appledorn upon being interviewed, was extremely defensive. I even asked her why she was so defensive. In retrospect , I should have terminated the interview early. Not only did she deny hearing any of the allegations, she complained about how I did the investigation, and questioned the credibility of the witnesses. She claims the witnesses selectively listened to the police, and ignored any comments made by the youths. Appledorn also maintains that because the citizens do not know the true reason for the police presence, they have no right to complain , or form an opinion about what they observed.

Officer Archer upon being contacted , refused to be interviewed. It was only after he was compelled to be interviewed , that he participated. I believe you can read into his desire not to be involved in the investigation.

Sgt. Christiansen, was also very defensive during her interview. She believes that it is significant that none of the youths complained, that it was a third party complaint. As though the third party complaint should not have equal weight. She also appeared upset that I had not yet spoken to the 911 caller.

Based on the descriptions given by the witnesses, it was Officer Guelcher almost exclusively , who was using the profanity, being confrontational with the youths. Officer Guelcher ,when confronted with the allegations during his interview stated, I do not remember saying those things." He did not deny saying them. Officer Guelcher also denied several allegations pertaining to specific language. He describes his interaction with the black youths as cordial. And that the

interaction was pleasant. This description , is a startling contrast to what the Complainants overheard.

This investigator went to the home of every youth listed in the report. I was not successful in making contact with any of them.

The Complainants include a Child Psychologist, a Civil Engineer, and the Superintendent of Mpls. Parks and Recreation. They do not know each other, but were so offended by what they heard, they were motivated to file a complaint. And also take time to participate in the interview process.

If you apply simple logic to this case it is obvious who is being truthful. The Complainant's have no motivation to lie or embellish. The witnesses were all at varying distances from the incident, but certainly not standing in the same area as the officers. The Complainants heard the language, as well as the emotion and inflection in the voice of the officers. But yet, we are to believe that the officers at the scene, and in close proximity to Officer Guelcher heard none of it. It is preposterous from anyone to accept that.

### INCIDENT

Several Complainant's reported they witnessed and overheard a situation involving a group of black youths at Gold Medal Park.

### SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

Inappropriate language , attitude, and discrimination, displayed by it appears to be Officer Guelcher and 13.43 - Personnel Data

### DISCUSSION

This is an interim progress report . This complaint has taken on a more complex investigation than first thought. There are three independent citizen Complainant's who heard specific obscene language, a provocative attitude , as well as discriminatory comments from these two officers. This investigator has interviewed all three witnesses who are independent, professional people. All of them were credible , and offended by what they heard. I interviewed Officer Erika Christiansen who was on the scene.

Christiansen was defensive and upset about the complaint. She contended she never heard any comments from the other officers similar to those spelled out in the complaint. She also questioned what I had done in the investigation, and wondered why I had not done certain things. Finally, I interviewed Officer Appledorn. My interview with her was the impetus for generating this interim progress report.

From the very beginning of the interview, she was incredibly defensive. In fact , I asked

her early in the interview, why she was so defensive. She maintained she was not being defensive. I specifically asked her if she heard any of the language spelled out in the complaint. She denied hearing any of the comments in the complaint. She did admit to making a comment herself, but stated it was in response to being called a " racist bitch. She questioned why the witnesses heard nothing from the black youths. She was argumentative, and wanted to know why I had not done certain things in the investigation.

In hindsight, I should have terminated the interview. Officer Appledorn showed no respect to me or what I was trying to accomplish. She was argumentative and discourteous to me, a fellow city employee. I was offended on how she treated me. I found her denials , and her defensiveness very troubling. Her creditability during the interview was sorely lacking, in my opinion.

Her behavior changes the complexion of this case. I need this to be converted to an admin file, so I can interview the focus officer, Officer Guelcher. It is my opinion, that I go back and scour this file for further investigation, including interviewing a park police officer who was present. Any other suggestions are welcomed.
