- Participants are encouraged to stay in Batoche for the Back to Batoche festival. Information regarding festival campsites and fees will be distributed as it is available.
- **This journey will be a leisurely sightseeing trip we take as a group. All canoes must stay with the group and follow the directions of the organizers.**

- tent and camping gear
- hat, sunscreen, bug repellent

Participants may also wish to bring:

- musical instruments
- extra snacks
- your own plate and utensils. Reusing these items helps us reduce waste
