Enclosed is the Call to the 56th Annual Convention of CUPE BC. This year the Convention will be held at the Victoria Conference Centre, 720 Douglas Street, Victoria, commencing at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, May 1, 2019, continuing through until 4:00 pm on Saturday, May 4, 2019.

In order to have delegates seated at this Convention, per capita must be paid to February 28, 2019. This per capita must be paid prior to May 1, 2019 (as per the constitution).

This year we have moved to online registration for all delegates to convention. Online registration will be through WE Travel at www.wetravel.net. Please note that per capita is required to be paid up to November 30, 2018 in order to register your delegates. If you are unable to register your delegates via the online portal, please contact our office so that we can provide assistance.

Delegate Selection

CUPE conventions have seen excellent debates on the need to involve more equity seeking groups in our union activities. If there is more than one delegate spot please consider sending a member who self identifies as being from an equity seeking group including; but not limited to: Persons with Disability, Indigenous, LGBTQ2+, and Workers of Colour. In addition we always strive to build the next generation of union activists and encourage locals to consider new and young workers (30 and under) for delegates to convention.

CREDENTIALS
