PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FROM VICTORIA AIRPORT (YYJ) TO DOWNTOWN VICTORIA

There are two public bus routes that serve this trip: 72 and 88. Cost is \$2.50 cash fare. Approximately 1 hour and 10 minutes ride. Reverse for the return trip.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FROM BC FERRIES (SWARTZ BAY TERMINAL) TO DOWNTOWN VICTORIA

Take the Route 70 (Express) or 72 bus. Cost is \$2.50 cash fare. Approximately 1 hour ride for the express. 1 hour and 17 minutes for 72. Reverse for the return trip.

Note: you can also book Coach travel through the BC Ferries Connector operated by the Wilson Group. To book, go directly to their website at bcfconnector.com.
