

Online registration for CUPE BC's 2021 virtual convention is now open

Delegate and Alternate voucher codes have been generated based on each Local/District Council's specific delegate entitlement. **We ask Locals and District Councils to refrain from sharing this information, as it contains information specific to your Local and District Council.**

ADVISORY NOTES & REMINDERS

All Locals/District Councils sending delegates to Convention are asked to abide by the following guidelines and instructions:

- **PERSONAL (non-employer) EMAIL ADDRESSES ARE REQUIRED** – For voting and security login purposes, please note that delegates and alternates are required to register themselves using their **personal email addresses**. **Generic role accounts and work email addresses will not be accepted.**
- **INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATIONS ONLY** – Please note that the registration form only allows for **one registration at a time**. Again, we ask all delegates and alternates to complete their own registrations for this year's Convention.

- **USE THE APPROPRIATE VOUCHER CODE** – Upon clicking the registration link, please select the appropriate registration type: Delegates or Alternates. **When completing registration for either a delegate or alternate, please apply the appropriate voucher code provided by email.**

CAUTION: Do not apply the Delegate Voucher Code if you are registering as an Alternate or Guest. Since each voucher has been customized based on your local delegate entitlement, applying the incorrect voucher at registration will prevent you from registering your maximum number of delegates.

- **ALTERNATES**—Due to technical limitations with the platform and to ensure the integrity of the election process, only delegates will be able to attend and participate in election caucuses (Regional Vice-President and Diversity Vice- Presidents elections). Alternate delegates and guests will not be permitted to attend election caucuses. This restriction is a voting requirement, and the online platform does not have the ability to allow alternates to observe election caucus meetings.
- **CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENTS** – All Locals and District Councils sending delegates to the 2021 CUPE BC Convention must have met the following Constitutional requirements:
 1. *While Locals may proceed with registering their delegates, per capita must be paid to CUPE BC up to December 31, 2020 in order to have delegates participate at the 2021 Convention. Locals are also required to have made their monthly per capita tax payments to CUPE National up to and including February 2021 in order to participate in the CUPE BC Convention.*
 2. *Any CUPE BC per cap and registrations payments need to be in our office by May 10th, 2021.*
 3. *The deadline to register online is May 10, 2021. Please note that late registrations will not be possible in order to ensure delegates have access to the online platform and secure voting.*

- **REGISTRATION DEADLINE REMINDER** – As noted above, registrations for this year’s Convention will firmly close on **May 10th, 2021**. Due to technical limitations, please note that **no late registrations will be accepted**.
