## What is BHRS?

Behavioral Health and Rehabilitation Services (BHRS) or wraparound services are prescribed to children and adolescents by a psychiatrist or psychologist after completing a face-to-face evaluation. Our BHRS services are called "wraparound" because our trained clinicians and therapeutic support staff provide rehabilitative support in home, school, and community settings. Wraparound services are designed to alleviate the challenging behaviors directly in the environments in which they occur.



## The types of Wraparound services we provide are:

- **Behavior Specialist Consultant (BSC)** - Master's or PhD level clinicians work with the family and/or school to create a treatment plan for the child. The BSC works with the treatment team to help them incorporate the plan into their interactions with the child.
- **Mobile Therapy (MT)** - Master's or PhD level clinicians provide child-centered, family-focused, individual and family psychotherapy.
- **Therapeutic Support Staff (TSS)** - Work one-on-one with the child to implement the treatment plan. The TSS accompanies the child to school, community activities, and the home as prescribed in the treatment plan.

## What is STS?

School Therapeutic Services (STS) is a time limited school based therapeutic program. These services are prescribed to children and adolescents by a psychiatrist or psychologist after completing a face-to-face evaluation where it is determined that the child's diagnosis impacts his or her performance in school. CVCA currently operates within six school sites in Philadelphia: Feltonville Arts & Sciences, Feltonville Intermediate, William Cramp, Tilden, Locke and Pennypacker.

## The treatment team at each site consists of:

- **Site Manager (SM)** - Master's level clinician that manages the school sites and interacts with school administrator and counselors regarding the day-to-day operations of the program site.

- **Case Manager (CM)** - Provides collaborative support for all STS cases, engages families, and coordinates interagency meetings and evaluations.
- **Lead Clinician (LC)** - Master's level clinician provides individual therapy to children, conducts assessments, develops treatment plans, and collaborates with teachers, parents, child, and other clinical team members in determining the appropriate therapeutic approach for the child.
- **Group Mobile Therapy (GMT)** - Reviews topics specific to individual treatment of children through the use of group exercise, role-play, and behavioral rehearsal exercise.
- **Behavioral Health Worker (BHW)** - Provides individual support in the classroom and throughout the school by assisting the child in decreasing the frequency and intensity of disruptive behaviors.
