

Los Feliz Bridge Home

The third “A Bridge Home” center to open in Council District Four.

Location: 3210 & 3248 Riverside Drive, at the corner of Riverside Drive and Los Feliz Boulevard.

Structure type: Temporary Sprung structure.

Size: Total parcel size is approximately 28,500 square feet, housing structure is approximately 10,800 square feet.

Residents: Up to 100 men and women and their pets.

Services: On-site counseling & support, meals, hygiene, pet area, storage.

Service provider: People Assisting the Homeless (PATH).

Cost: \$7.096 Million, funded primarily through State grants.

Furniture/bedding: Furniture donated by Aether Apparel, pillows by Allied Feather & Down.

Project first proposed: February 6, 2019, in a [motion](#) introduced by Councilmember Ryu.

Construction timeline: February 26, 2020 - July 24, 2020.
