

COUNCIL DISTRICT SPECIFIC COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROGRAM

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I am an arts organization, commercial business, or individual artist that lives outside of the Council Districts mentioned in your guidelines. Can I still apply for this COVID-19 award?

Unfortunately, at this time, the COVID-19 Emergency Response Program is only open to arts organizations, commercial businesses, and individual artists that reside in Council District 1, 3, 4, 8, and 10.

The last time I applied for this award, the application window closed before the advertised deadline. Will that happen again?

This submission deadline is September 23, 2020, or whenever we reach 300 submissions, whichever is first. Do not hesitate to apply for this opportunity. DCA will announce via social media when we are at the halfway mark of receiving applications.

I am an individual artist and applied to your CITYWIDE COVID-19 Emergency Response Program. Am I eligible to apply to the Council District Specific COVID-19 Emergency Response Program?

If you are from Council District 1, 3, 4, 8, or 10, we encourage you to apply for the Council District specific program. However, you will only be eligible to receive one (1) award, should you be identified as a recipient for either award. Please note that applicants from the Citywide COVID-19 Emergency Response Program will be notified during the end of September.

When will I be notified if I am selected?

The Council District Specific COVID-19 Emergency Response Program applicants will be notified via email by the end of October 2020.

If I am selected, when will I receive funds?

The funding will be made available in two (2) installments, and we plan to release the first payment by the end of October or the first week of November 2020.
