Things to include in your submission:

Include in the heading:

The name of the select committee to which it is addressed:
Local Government and Environmental Committee

And the full title of the bill:
Resource Legislation Amendment Bill 2015

Clearly state in your submission whether you support or oppose the Resource Legislation Amendment Bill. Even better, if you believe particular clauses need to be either withdrawn or changed, say so, and give your reasons.
