Mayoral candidate Diane Therrien to host series of community drop-ins

PETERBOROUGH – With July upon us, Mayoral candidate Diane Therrien wants to pull up a seat and talk to people in their own neighbourhoods as she hosts a series of community drop-in conversations across the city.

This is an opportunity for city residents to meet Therrien in a casual setting to discuss issues important to their wards and to share their vision for the future of Peterborough.

“One of the great things about Peterborough is that every neighbourhood has its own heartbeat with unique issues, challenges and opportunities,” Therrien said. “When you get a chance to meet people in the places they live, you come away with a deeper understanding of the many community voices in this city.”

Therrien was pleased to host the first drop-in at the Silver Bean Café in Town Ward on June 22 where community members engaged in an active dialogue over issues such as housing, income insecurity and transparency. Therrien followed this on June 26 with a drop-in for Otonabee Ward residents at Lansdowne Place mall.

“My platform focuses on three fundamentals of building a strong community – jobs, taxes, and infrastructure,” Therrien said. “As I canvass ideas from a broad range of residents in the city, I’m hearing that we need to be focusing on these basics and we need to make sure we get them right.”

The next drop-ins in July will take place in Monaghan, Northcrest and Ashburnham wards.
