Executive Committee

Executive Committee Members serve a two-year term and are required to attend two meetings per year (usually in early Spring and late Fall). The nominees of the Precinct meetings to the County Executive Committee are elected at the County Convention. Convention Delegates/Alternates

Convention Delegates serve a one-year term and are voting members at the respective convention. Please consider being a delegate or alternate to these events. Nominal registration fees are collected for County and District Conventions and for the two-day State Convention. Delegates will be mailed complete information in advance of each convention.
