# Adding Websites to your bookmarks




You may be asking, what is a bookmark? Well, we are not talking about the notes you make in the margins. We are talking about a place to store sites you like so you can find them later. Let's take a look at what I'm talking about. Remember our friend Google? This is where it will begin. First let's find a site.

I've typed in the search box outlined in (blue), beaufort county government washington nc. You will notice the drop down menu (gray arrow). I'm going to click on the first option and show you what happens. Nothing new, you saw it in the last session, Google search fundamentals. I hope you read that one. You did didn't you?



If you notice there are several options to choose from as indicated by the (gray arrows). Don't forget about the Green Monster. I know, quit kidding around. I can't help myself. We want to choose the first option surrounded by the (blue Box).




Wow, now that's what I call progress. Sorry got a little excited. When we clicked that link it sent us to the Beaufort County site. I only captured the top part of the site so you could see that clicking the link we chose took us to where we wanted to be. Now we will start getting our hands dirty. That is after I show you what we came here for "bookmarks."



Here, we are looking at the top of the page that we are visiting. I will blow up sections you'll need to familiarize yourself with so you can save them in your "bookmarks." That's for those of us who have a harder time seeing. Well for some of us.




If you notice the (blue box) surrounding the star at the top right, that is what's called the "Bookmark" icon. This is the button you will click on to add it to your "bookmarks." Let's click the star. I didn't say reach for the stars, I said click it. Oh, sorry, you did it. I must have been sleeping.




You notice the dropdown menu. This part is important. To add a bookmark folder, you'll want to click on the box that says "More..." The one with the (blue box) around it. Sorry, you can't click it, I have to so you can see what happens. Here I go.

Now we have another box that popped up called the "Edit bookmark" box. The box at the top surrounded by the (blue box). Don't worry, if it seems like to much to take in, you can always come back. You will want to click the "Other bookmarks folder" the one with the (red arrow) beside it before selecting the "New folder" button at the bottom surrounded with a (blue box).


Once you have selected the "Other bookmarks folder" you noticed it turned blue. By selecting it first, you allow the new folder we create to be part of its family. If you look at the folders underneath it surrounded by the (blue box) you'll see what I mean. Whew, I know you want to give up but don't. It took me a while to learn, so you're not alone.

Now we can click on the "New folder button" surrounded by the (blue box) below.



If you noticed, a "New folder" box appeared. This is where you will place the website you want to save, but first we need to give it a name. *No, not Fido your dog.* It needs to be a name to identify what you are placing in the folder like: County Websites, NC House Site, or something like that. *You get the idea.* Now let's name your file.



Notice the new folder you created has a name "New folder." *Go figure.* The name is highlighted in blue and is surrounded by a blue box. *This isn't my box, it's one the web browser creates.* To change the name, all you have to do is start typing and the words "New folder" will be replaced by the name you type in the box.




If for some reason the box changes to a highlighted blue "New folder" without the blue box surrounding it and you can't change the name, don't worry. *It's happened to me many times*. All you have to do is place your cursor over the highlighted word and right click you mouse. *Your other right*. *I say that because... you got it...say it in unison with me...Its happened to me*. Let me show you what happens when you right click the highlighted word.


There it is. Another menu box. I told you not to worry. Here you want to click on the word "Edit." I surrounded it with MY (blue box). This will change it back so you can add the file name you want. Let's try it and see.

Well I'll be a cat's meow we did it. Now start typing and you'll see the name change. Kind of like magic don't you think? Okay, maybe not. Just a thought. We'll call this file, "County Government." You don't have to call yours that if you don't want to. Let's see what happened when we did.

Notice how the name changed? Now all we have to do is click the blue "Save" button I surrounded in a (blue box). Let's save it now and see what happens.



Oh no, it went away. Don't panic, I know where it went. If you'll be nice I'll show you. We'll save that for module 2a. I don't want to wear you out on the first long session. See you at 2a.
