Orange County Budget Alert!

Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) Update Involvement in BOCC meetings is important as key issues and decisions impacting all of us are being made with little Conservative input. As taxpayers and citizens of Orange County we will benefit by attending meetings of interest that arise on the BOCC calendar. The 7 member BOCC meets at 7PM on the first Tuesday of the month in Hillsborough and the third Tuesday in Chapel Hill. Click here for the complete meeting calendar.

Below is a short summary by Riley Ruske, who regularly attends BOCC meetings. We need more support to exercise our viewpoint at these meetings. Please join us!

OC Board of County Commissioners Actions for the 2020 - 2021 County Budget Orange County has the highest property and sales taxes in the state of North Carolina. County management and the Board are currently working on the 500 page 2020 - 2021 budget. There are many issues of excessive spending in this budget. This is not an austerity budget; spending increases from the current \$272.4 million dollars to \$273.6 million dollars. This appears to be a small increase of \$1.2 million dollars, but the spending increase over the two year 2019 - 2021 period is \$15 million dollars and would have been even more if not for the Wuhan virus crisis.

County Government cancelled the planned property tax and solid waste fee increases. However, the management is warning of a probable increase in the property tax rate of 5.26 cents over the next two years!!! The problem is not a revenue problem. Revenues are expected to increase about \$4 million dollars: \$2.5 from property tax and \$1.5 from sales tax. *The problem is a spending and borrowing problem*: Orange County government simply considers the taxpayers an endless well of money for them to spend.

The public hearing on the county budget will be a virtual meeting on **Thursday**, **June 4 at 7PM**. For more information about how to stream live or have your voice heard, visit this <u>link</u>.
