

## **RESOLUTION ENSURING THE CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS OF THE PEOPLE TO FAIR, LEGAL, ACCURATE AND TIMELY ELECTIONS**

**WHEREAS** the 6th Congressional District believes that elections must be conducted with absolute fairness and integrity, regardless of party registration, race, or socio-economic resources, and that every vote should count and not be canceled out by illegal votes; and

**WHEREAS** the federal government is specifically and intentionally limited by the Constitution of the United States - with non-enumerated powers being reserved to the people; and

**WHEREAS** constitutional rules for conducting elections are specifically reserved to the state legislatures; and

**WHEREAS** NC Attorney General Josh Stein, and NC Board of Elections Chair Karen Brinson Bell (appointed by Governor Roy Cooper) conspired with Democratic operative Marc Elias to push a false election narrative that caused massive absentee-by-mail voting when they unconstitutionally disregarded previously legislated laws concerning the treatment of absentee ballots; and

**WHEREAS** similar dishonest election manipulation activity has led to the sanctioning of Marc Elias and other Perkins Coie lawyers by the 5th Circuit Court of Appeals; and

**WHEREAS** the Elias-Stein-Bell conspiracy created de facto unequal access to the polls for NC voters who voted by mail-in ballots (longer voting period, more lax ballot verification, even rules changes after significant votes had already been cast) versus in-person voters; and

**WHEREAS** the outcome of some races were changed by the allowance of these otherwise illegal ballots; and

**WHEREAS** the same Board of Elections is presently attempting to limit and hamstring legal poll observers in the future; and

**WHEREAS** a Joint Committee from the NC General Assembly should oversee elections appeals decisions of the NC Board of Elections in real time; therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the 6th Congressional District desires the following election parameters be included in law:

1. Legislative refusal by the NC General Assembly to acquiesce to federal overreach and any attempts to federalize elections;
2. Curtail the emergency powers of the NC Governor by requiring the consensus of the Council of State on all emergency related matters, including;
3. Votes shall be counted in such a manner as to ensure transparency and final results will be delivered on Election Night;
4. Voters must provide legal justification for the acquisition of an Absentee ballot. The deadline for receipt will be 5pm on Election Day (with adequate ballot request and mail deadlines to ensure receipt at the Board of Elections by that deadline);
5. Photo ID will be required of all voters, regardless of voting method;
6. Thorough investigation and consideration will be given to the merits of counting votes in the precincts on Election Night, using mandatory and verified bipartisan teams;
7. A mandatory statewide audit of paper ballots cast in at least three random races in every county; and also

**BE IT RESOLVED** that copies of this resolution be sent to the North Carolina Republican Party for consideration and adoption at its convention.
