## Update: Nova Scotia loosens COVID-19 restrictions

The Premier announced today (June 18th) that they have eliminated the family bubble and are now allowing gatherings of 10 people without the need for physical distancing or PPE. The province says people in the 10-person groups are not required to be exclusive, but are encouraged to be consistent to mitigate the risk of possible reintroduction of COVID-19.

While film and television production is exempt from gathering limits, groups of 50 people can now gather while maintaining physical distancing protocols.

Screen Nova Scotia's Health and Safety Protocol Document will be made publicly available via Screen Nova Scotia's communication channels, including a new webpage. This will happen as soon as the revisions are made to reflect today's announcement, and approvals from Labour and Advanced Education and Dr. Strang have been granted.
