APPOINTMENT TO SHADOW MINISTRY

I am honoured to have been appointed as the Shadow Minister for Skills and Apprenticeships and Shadow Minister for Housing and Homelessness and I am grateful to the Leader of the Opposition for the opportunity to serve Labor in portfolios that are central to a fair and decent society.

I congratulate my predecessors in these portfolios, Sharon Bird and Senator Katy Gallagher for their great work in the last Parliament and I look forward to working with Labor's outstanding team in the Education and Social Services portfolios.
