

FINAL RESULTS

uComms conducted a survey of 639 residents across the QLD federal electorate of Herbert on the night of the 28 & 29 November 2018.

Question:

The Queensland government has offered Adani special deals which mean the company will avoid paying a reported \$370M in royalties, get a \$100 million publicly-funded road upgrade and enjoy a licence to take unlimited water for 60 years.

Do you support or oppose the state government giving Adani special deals and subsidies?
